#### September Reflection

Philippians 2:12-13 "Therefore, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed me, not only in my presence, but much more now in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who is at work in you, enabling you both to will and to work for his good pleasure."

Covid has made me realize just how much of life I took for granted prior to March 2020. From the big things, like coming to church, not being in fear of either contracting or sharing a deadly virus, to the little things like not wearing a mask on my face and eating in restaurants. I took so much for granted, and I believe often in times of strife, we search for silver linings, we grasp for something good to take with us from otherwise bad situations. If I can say I learned one good thing over this past season of pandemic, it is this, don't take anything for granted.

It is in this spirit that I share with you something that I have missed perhaps more than anything else is Bible Study. I love Bible Study, I love that time we set aside to dive deep into Scripture, to become immersed in the word and then to have conversation about it. Scripture is vast and interesting that even the most mundane Scripture (I'm looking at you Leviticus) deserves to be treated with a reverence and curiosity, that often we cannot completely delve into it on a Sunday morning.

Sermons for a variety of reasons are a decidedly one-sided discourse. I as the pastor share with you what a week's worth of study and prayer have revealed. Bible Study on the other hand is when we pull together using our collective imagination to not only discern what a particular author of Scripture was getting at, but also to hear what the Holy Spirit may be revealing to us as a group.

To say that I have missed this time would be an understatement. So starting on Wednesday 9/8 at 6:30pm we will meet in the June Medlin class for the beginning of a new Bible Study. If you have attended Bible Study before I hope that you will return. If you have not been a part of Bible Study before, I hope that you will take this restart as a time to begin. The best news is that we will all be starting from the same place.

Of course with the restart of Bible Study you might be wondering what part of Scripture we will begin with. After careful thought and consideration I have decided to open up with four of the Pastoral Epistles, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, and Colossians to be exact. Over the course of this study we will focus on how each letter shines a light on a different aspect of discipleship. In Galatians we will be looking specifically at the role grace plays in discipleship, in Ephesians we will be looking at how ethics inform our lives as disciples, in Philippians we will be looking at the process of discipleship, and in Colossians we will be looking the way community impacts discipleship.

I hope that as you think about 6:30pm on Wednesday night, you will prayerfully consider coming to

Bible Study, so that we all may hear the words of instruction Paul has for us as disciples of Jesus Christ.




