## MENOMINEE TOWNSHIP, MENOMINEE COUNTY, MICHIGAN AMENDMENT 1, PLANNING COMMISSION ORDINANCE Ordinance Number: 4-24-19-01

The purpose of Amendment 1, Menominee Township Ordinance 4-24-19-01 is to amend paragraph 104 and 109 of Menominee Township Planning Commission Ordinance 10-21-09-1 to comply with PA 33 of 2008, Michigan Planning Enabling Act, MCL 125.3801.

Section 1. Referencing Section 104 of the original document (Menominee Twp Planning Commission Ordinance # 10-21-09-1):

A. Delete paragraph 104 A. 104 B. and 104 C. Add a general statement after paragraph number and title; 104. Members, Appointment and Terms: "Planning Commission appointment and terms will be in accordance with details outlined in MCL 125.3815".

Clarification for preceding paragraph: The law states that the chief elected official (township supervisor) shall appoint members of the Planning Commission, subject to approval by majority vote of the members of the elected/serving legislative body. Maximum term limits are not a state requirement. How the Township Supervisor achieves the best appointment results is not covered by state law or sub-detailed in this ordinance.

B. Add to paragraph 109 two subparagraphs:

"109 10. Per MCL 125.3819 Sec 19 (2), the Menominee Township Planning Commission shall make an annual written report no later than January 31<sup>st</sup> for the preceding calendar year, to the Menominee Township Board of Trustees, concerning its operations, the status of planning, budgetary needs, parks and recreation, grants and any recommendations to the Township Board related to planning and development.

109. 11. Per MCL 125.3815 Sec 15 (10), the Menominee Township Planning Commission shall oversee Parks and Recreational Development, and may appoint a separate committee if necessary to assist. Development and/or updates of the Parks and Recreational Plan will be maintained by the Planning Commission and approved by majority vote of the Township Board of Trustees. "
