Members Reports

Dad and Son Fishing in Mexico By Laney Hackman

Well I missed the Christmas Banquet for the first time in many years - but I have a good reason. I was in Mexico with my son Dustin fishing largemouth bass at Lake El Salto, and we had such a fun trip.

We flew out of Tijuana (which was a first for me) to Culican, Mexico and then took a van for about 2 hours to Angler's Inn at Lake El Salto - a freshwater lake. We fished the first afternoon upon arriving and every day from Dec 9th - 15th. After the first day we would be on the water before dawn and fish to about 11:30 AM. Then it was back to the lodge for lunch and a short rest. We would be back on the water about 1:00 and fish until it got dark. We caught lots of bass every day. Most fish were in the 1 -3lb range, but we also caught quite a few fish in the 4 & 5 lb range, some 6's, and we each got at least one over 7. We caught our fish on rubber worms & lizards, jerk baits, lots on wacky sencos, poppers, rattletraps, and all of our biggest fish were caught on zara spooks - which was a blast to see those large fish attack surface plugs. Basically everyone at this lodge fishes 2 people to a boat with a guide. All of the guides speak Spanish with a bit of English they have picked up. The resort was very comfortable with good food and excellent service. If anyone would like to know more about this trip just let me know.

Happy New Year to everybody and let's hope we all get lots of time on the water this year.
