

**Wyatt, Ronald H.**

Ronald H. Wyatt, 80, of Port Austin, died Friday July 10, 2009 at Courtney Manor in Bad Axe. He was born on Jan. 11, 1929 in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., son of the late Maury and Emma (Hahn) Wyatt.

He moved with his parents to Philadelphia, where he grew up.

Ron married Jane Hodges on Sept. 12, 1980 in Bryan, Ohio.

Ron received his education at the German Town Academy and Moravian College. He served in the United States Navy and Army and was a Korean War Veteran. He worked for 30 years at Harvard Industries as a Quality Control Manager. Following their retirement, Ron and Jane moved to Port Austin in 2004. Ron was very active in community activities. He served on the Port Austin Village Council and Planning Commission, was treasurer of the Thumb Art Guild (TAG), sold books at the Farmer's Market benefiting the Friends of the Library in Port Austin, and helped to promote the Veterans Memorial Water Park.

He is survived by his wife, Jane; his son, Dave (Linda) Wyatt of Columbia, Md.; two step-daughters; Kirsten (John) Allen of Ypsilanti and Sherri (Chris) Halucha of Hampton Bays, N.Y.; two granddaughters, Angie (Jon) Robinson of Hanover, Md. and Patricia Wyatt of Ellicott City, Md.; four step-grandchildren, Elizabeth, Joshua, and Anna Allen, and Benjamin Halucha; and one great-grandchild Makenzie Robinson. A brother-in-law, Ed Hodges of Tecumseh, also survives him.

His parents and his stepmother, Gladys Wyatt, preceded him in death.
