Dear Parents,



BHPCNS leadership continues to work with the leadership of the Bradley Hills Presbyterian Church on an April 2021 reopening. The decision to reopen the school is one church leadership will be reviewing throughout the fall. We will be looking at Maryland State, Montgomery County, and CDC guidelines, as well as the expertise of the leadership teams to determine best reopening practices, including mask wearing and having more outdoor programming, beginning in April 2021. 


Please complete the <u>Interest in Enrolling</u> survey by October 15, 2020 to help us work towards a reopening that works for everyone in our community. Thank you!

Despite being currently closed, BHPCNS is preparing to fully reopen our program in September 2021. Registration is open to children or all races, faiths, ethnic backgrounds, and nationalities.

Children must be the age they are applying for by September 1, 2021. For example, a child applying to the 3s' program, must turn 3 by September 1, 2021 to be age-appropriate for the 3s' program.

Registration for New Families, Your Friends, & Neighbors will begin on October 12, 2020



Registration for Siblings of Current BHPCNS Students will begin on October 12, 2020

October 2020 is the time to submit applications for the 2021-2022 school year for siblings of currently enrolled children. (Currently enrolled children include all children enrolled at BHPCNS for the 2020-2021 school year.)


Applications will be available online at the BHPCNS website, <u>www.bhpcns.org</u> beginning October 7th for children who will be starting at BHPCNS in September 2021. Acceptance and Wait List notifications will be sent home in late January 2021.

Children must turn 2 by September 1, 2021 to be considered for enrollment.



BHPCNS REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration for Currently Enrolled BHPCNS Students will be December 15th and 16th 2020 (BHPCNS students who are currently enrolled for 2020-2021 school year will receive priority in the admissions process over students who will be new to the school for the 2021-2022 school year.)



Registration for **children currently enrolled at BHPCNS** will take place on December 15th and 16th, 2020. Applications will be available on the BHPCNS website at <u>www.bhpcns.org</u>, by mid-November 2020. Download and complete the application. Applications should be returned to BHPCNS no earlier than December 15th and no later than December 16th 2020 in order to be given priority in enrollment. Please recognize that children currently enrolled in our 2s and 3s' program as well as those children who are enrolled in the 4s' program but are not age eligible for Kindergarten, are guaranteed a place, but, it may not be your first choice. Acceptance is based on a first-come, first-serve basis. Families will be notified in late January as to their child's placement for the 2020-2021 school year.

Registration for Young 2's Program will begin February 2021

Children who turn 2 between September 2, 2020 and December 31, 2020 are eligible for BHPCNS' Young 2s' program. The Young 2s' program will run between January 2022 and June 2022. Applications for this program will be available on the BHPCNS website in February 2021. To learn more about the Young 2s' program contact the school office at 301-365-2909 and we will return your call as soon as possible. The school will be conducting adult-only tours on a limited basis in small groups.




SCRIPTED SOCIAL STORIES: TUCKER THE TURTLE

For more information on Social Stories, visit Vanderbilt University's SEFEL website by <u>clicking here.</u> At BHPCNS we use Scripted Stories for Social Situations to help children understand social interactions, situations, expectations, social cues, and social rules. As the title implies, the stories are brief descriptive stories that provide information regarding a social situation. When children are given information that helps them understand the expectations of a situation, their problem behavior within that situation is reduced or minimized.

Traditionally, we kick off our school year with Tucker the Turtle. He's a little turtle that has trouble controlling his emotions. Using 4 simple steps he quickly learns how to: Stop, Think, Count to 3, and Find a solution.

I hope you and your child(ren) will enjoy getting to know Tucker.


