

ORDINANCE 23A

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LOG CABIN, TEXAS; ESTABLISHING OF A SYSTEM FOR NUMBERING OF RESIDENCES AND PROPERTY LOCATIONS.

WHEREAS, because of conditions prevailing in the City of Log Cabin, the general welfare requires that all property, particularly residences, be identified by street address numbers for ready identification by emergency services, utilities, delivery, and tradesmen purposes.

APPLICATION:

It shall be required that a correct 911 physical street address number be erected on each occupied lot within the city, bearing three (3) inch by three (3) inch numbers large enough to be easily read from the street.

Numbers shall be contrasting color from the background color of the application i.e., black letters on white background. Signs should clearly visible, facing the street at said address.

While only numbers are required to facilitate quick location at a given address, the following street designations are applied to existing streets:

Travis Lane from Wyatt Earp to the loop, running parallel to Daniel Boone (in front of old City Hall Building) is designated as West Travis lane. The other section of Travis Lane which runs parallel to West Travis from the loop to Wyatt Earp is designated as East Travis Lane.

Sam Houston, which runs from Goliad Drive north to the loop, is designated West Sam Houston; and that portion from the loop to Davy Crockett is designated as East Sam Houston.

That portion of Davy Crockett which lies west of Alamo Road is designated West Davy Crockett; and that portion lying east of Alamo Road is designated as East Davy Crockett.

That portion of Goliad Drive from Tom Hickman to 1560 Goliad is designated as North Goliad. From 1560 Goliad to 1603 (Ambush Lane) is designated as West Goliad; from Ambush Lane/Goliad Drive intersection to Bill Cody is designated as South Goliad

San Jacinto Drive from Tom Hickman to lot 851 (curve) is designated as North San Jacinto; and the remainder, from lot 851 to intersection of Cherokee Lane, is designated as West San Jacinto.


EMERGENCY PROVISION

WHEREAS, an emergency exists, for the necessity of identifying of property by address, that requires this ordinance to become effective immediately; therefore it shall become effective from and after the date of its passage and all rules and regulations provided for the reading of this ordinance on more than once occasion or more than one time, are hereby suspended.

PENALTY CLAUSE.

Failure to comply with such provisions of this ordinance shall result in a citation of no less than \$50.00 or more than \$100.00 plus State Court Cost for each offense. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day the violation continues.
