Application for Membership

Dear Applicant,

Appraisers National Association (ANA) actively seeks the membership of professionals who have an interest in the issues related to the appraisal of personal property, and pride themselves on meeting the highest standards of professional appraisal practice.

There are currently Four (4) categories of membership:

Certified Accredited Appraiser (CAA) Sanctioned by ANA to Appraise.

1. CAA Applicants must have successfully completed the educational requirements for certification from a recognized educational institution, appraisal society, or equivalent professional training and experience recognized by ANA.
2. CAA Applicants using certification from the above mentioned organizations or institutions shall provide the ANA Review Board certification documents from said organization or institution or any other documentation necessary to determine eligibility. Include any additional advanced certifications i.e. Fine Art, Textiles, Collectibles.
3. CAA Applicants must include a copy of a recent comprehensive written appraisal in accordance with current USPAP guidelines.
4. Each CAA applicant must have successfully completed the 15-hour Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice (USPAP) course and exam and be up to date with current USPAP edition.
5. Every appraisal assignment must comply with USPAP by meeting the current guidelines established by USPAP.
6. Every CAA must comply with the ANA code of ethics.*

Student Member (SM) Not Sanctioned by ANA to Appraise.

Individuals who are currently enrolled in a course of instruction from a recognized educational institution. Applicants shall provide documentation showing current enrollment.

Student Associates must comply with the ANA Code of Ethics.*

Associate Member (AM) Not Sanctioned by ANA to Appraise.

Individuals or businesses whose main interest is in the field of personal property appraising i.e. Estate Sellers, Dealers, Auctioneers, Estate Buyers, Brokers or other Related Professions.

Associate Members must comply with the ANA Code of Ethics.*

Expert Consultant (EC) Not Sanctioned by ANA to Appraise.

Individuals who demonstrate a high level of expertise in a singular narrow field of specialization. For example: Specialty Scholars, Curators, Conservators, Linguists, Collectors, Authors, Historians, Attorneys, Insurance Specialists etc.

Expert Consultants must comply with ANA Code of Ethics.*

Note: Any educational, professional and/or USPAP information provided will be verified.

Certified Accredited Appraiser (CAA), Associate Member (AM) and Expert Consultant (EC) applications must be accompanied by a \$50.00 application processing fee. This fee is non-refundable. [Student Member (SM) exempt from the \$50.00 application processing fee.]

\$75.00 for Student Member (SM)	If paying by credit card \$80.00
\$50.00 for Expert Consultant (EC)	If paying by credit card \$55.00

New members: Membership dues will be billed upon completion of the application process and acceptance of membership. Dues are prorated for those joining after the start of the established membership year.
