There have been several things happening at the museum:

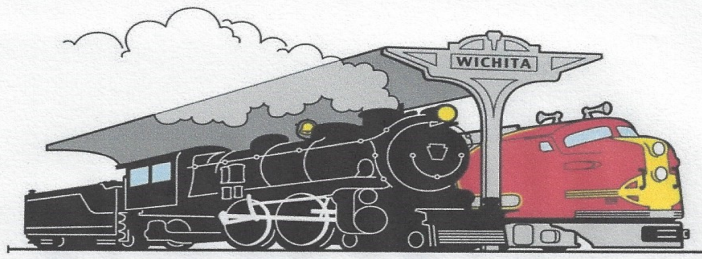

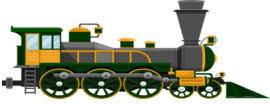




It's On Its Way!
