Treasurer's Report – Barb Drake read the Treasurer's report for July 31, 2020. It was approved

President's Report – Due to Covid 19 many things at the club have been cancelled. Joan complimented members for sanitizing the club as they used it during the last six months. She reminded members that the club has all the desanitizing equipment available. She reminded members that the shields were not sufficient face cover and you needed to wear a mask also. There have been members training in the building during this time and that was good so that the building didn't sit empty if something happened.
