Your CUPE 116 bargaining committee began negotiations with the University on Thursday April 18, 2019. The parties exchanged proposal overview documents and provided a broad outline of our respective positions.

Based on the initial exchange of proposal documents, we believe that there are areas of common interest. We can also confirm that the University has not proposed to contract out or layoff any portions of our membership.

The University has agreed to seven more bargaining dates over the next few weeks and we have proposed several other dates as well. Your CUPE 116 bargaining committee is intent on achieving the strongest improvements to the Collective Agreement as possible.

The bargaining committee will keep you updated as bargaining proceeds.
