BISMARCK HIGH: The Demons (16-11 Overall; 12-6 WDA) placed sixth t the Class A Tournament in Bismarck last week. The Demons fell to G.F. Red River, 73-66, in the quarterfinals before rebounding with a 77-70 loser-out victory over Devils Lake. In the consolation championship, BHS loss to rival Century, 87-60.

Against Red River, Brayden Thomas had a team-high 23 points and 15 rebounds. Connor Hellebust added 20 points. BHS trailed 31-28 at halftime. GFRR received 16 points from its reserves while BHS had none.

Against DL, Hellebust finished with a team-best 24 points. Thomas netted 14 and Ernest Grant, 13. BHS led 40-32 at halftime and enjoyed a 13-point lead at one point in the second half

Against Century, Hellebust had a team-high 20 points. BHS trailed 36-23 at halftime and were down by as many as 28 in the second half. It was the Demons' third loss to BHS this season. Connor Hellebust was named to the all-tournament team Hellebust and Thomas were named to the All-WDA team

CENTURY: The Patriots (24-3 Overall; 18-0 WDA) won the consolation championship at last week's Class A Tournament in Bismarck. After dropping a quarterfinal game to West Fargo, 67-65, in overtime in the quarterfinals, Century rebounded with a 83-69 victory over Dickinson in loser-out play and then downed rival Bismarck High, 87-60. Against West Fargo, Dalton Feeney had a team-high 23 points. Luke Leingang added 19 and Lucas Mayer had 12. Century trailed by seven in the first half before rallying to take a 32-27 lead at halftime. The game featured nine ties and four lead changes. The loss was Century's second straight.

Against Dickinson, Feeney had a team-high 18 points. Leingang netted 16 and Andrew Holen, 10. Century led 46-32 at halftime and led by as many as 26 points in the second half. Century defeated Dickinson three times this season.

Against BHS, Luke Leingang had a team-high 19 points. Four other players were in double figures: Michael Olson, 15; Adam Geiger, 12; Feeney, 11; Sam Leidholm, 10. The Patriots led 36-23 at halftime had enjoyed a 28-point lead at one point in the second half en route to the victory.

Dalton Feeney was named to the all-tournament team and was also named state senior athlete of the year. Century's Darin Mattern was named state coach of the year. Feeney, Adam Geiger and Andrew Holen were all-WDA selections.

DICKINSON The Midgets (16-10 Overall: 12-6 WDA) ended their season with a pair of losses at the Class A Tournament in Bismarck last week. Dickinson gave the East Region's top seed Fargo Davies all it could handle in the quarterfinals, before falling in overtime, 91-86. Dickinson then dropped a 83-69 loser-out game to Century. Against Fargo Davies, Aanen Moody had a game-high 37 points, including 10-10 from the free throw line. Wyatt Kainz had 14; Jordan Meidinger, 13; Shawn Steffan, 11. Meidinger had seven blocked shots and 14 rebounds. The Midgets trailed by 12 points in the second half before rallying to force OT. Dickinson played in three OT games this season, winning one.

Against Century, Moody finished with a game-high 31 points. Jordan Meidinger netted 12. The Midgets trailed 46-32 at halftime and never led in the contest The Midgets were making their first tournament appearance since 2009. Aanen Moody was named to the all-tournament team. Moody and Meidinger were named to the All-WDA team

The Magicians opened the tournament with a 73-58 victory over Devils Lake in the quarterfi nals and then overcame an early deficit to defeat G.F. Red River in the semifinals. Against DL, KyJuan Johnson had a team-high 18 points. Justin Engg finished with 17 and Braydon Lund had 10. Lund also finished with 13 rebounds. Minot led by 11 points at halftime and stretched its lead to as many as 23 in the second half. Minot went to the free throw line 38 times compere to just 11 by the Firebirds. The win was Minot's second over DL this season.

Against Red River, Minot overcame a slow start to eventually take a 29-24 lead by halftime. The lead was then extended to as many as 23 points in the second half. Johnson had a team-high 17 points. Lund netted 15; Jesse Roberts, 10. Minot outscored GFRR 13-5 in bench scoring and was 18 of 26 from the free throw line competed to just 5 of 7 for the Roughriders.
