DESCRIPTION: All Wilson Brothers Black Widow bows are highly valued, and the iconic Model X-99 was the most popular of the bunch. Great looking and performing target recurve in excellent condition. The only thing that keeps this bow from being in mint condition is the filled screw holes that have been expertly filled and are barely visible (see pics on last page). Select hardwood riser with Rosewood trim. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. Typical "yellowing" of the limbs. The limbs are a uniform color, but may appear discolored in some of the pics (it's a glare/camera thing). No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; no stress lines. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Bow specs are in excellent condition. I had planned to keep this bow as one of the 6 I'm retaining for my personal shooter collection, but given my age I decided to keep my 30# Black Widow X-99 instead. This bow is gorgeous.


