JAPAN



- Take a guided tour of Tokyo and visit the Asakusa Kannon Temple, Meiji Shrine and Imperial Gardens, view the Imperial Palace and go backstage at Suntory Hall
- Enjoy a cultural exchange and joint performance with local schools
- Perform on the public stages, and attend a workshop with Disney Performing Arts at Tokyo Disney Theme Park, then spend the rest of the day exploring the park and the rides
- For a truly different experience, visit the Tsukiji Fish Market where over 2000 tons of fish are sold each day
- Take a guided day trip to Yokohama and Kamakura. Visit Sankei-en Garden, Yokohama Red Brick Warehouse, Hachiman-gu Shrine and the Great Buddha
- Travel to Hakone home to famous Mt Fuji and go up to the 5th Station. At Lake Kawaguchi, one of the Fuji Five Lakes take a cable car and enjoy the panoramic view of Mt. Fuji
- Stay in a traditional Japanese Ryokan overnight and sample the culture and cuisine of Japan
- Extend your trip to other cities, maybe by bullet train – Nagoya, Kyoto, Osaka or Hiroshima

CHINA



- Tour Beijing to see all the famous sights – the Temple of Heaven, Summer Palace, Forbidden City and Tiananmen Square, the 2008 Olympic precinct with the 'Birds Nest' stadium and 'Water Cube' aquatic centre
- Take a masterclass with leading professors at the Central Conservatory of Music, or enjoy a cultural exchange and joint performance with students of traditional Chinese music at the China Conservatory
- Test your bargaining skills at the Silk Markets and visit workshops to watch artisans using their ancient skills
- Attend a performance of traditional Chinese opera and go backstage to see the amazing makeup and costumes
- Participate in the Tutti World Youth Music Festival in Beijing with young musicians from around the world
- Extend your tour north to Xi'an to see the renowned Terracotta Warriors, or travel to Shanghai or Guangzhou for a taste of modern China

SINGAPORE and HONG KONG



- Spend time in a cultural exchange and joint performance with a local school
- In Singapore shop on Orchard Road, visit Little India, try Chilli Crab at the Red House in East Coast Park, Ride the Singapore Flyer, take the cable car to Sentosa Island for some time at the aquarium or on the beach, then see the beautiful National Orchid Gardens or the stunning Gardens By The Bay
- In Hong Kong take the Star Ferry to Kowloon for amazing city and harbour views, take the cable car to see the Tian Tan Buddha and Po Lin monastery, or ride the Peak Tram to the top of Victoria Peak. Visit Ocean Park, the Museum of Art, the Wong Tai Sin temple or the Zoological and Botanic Gardens
- Attend a concert by the Singapore Symphony or Hong Kong Philharmonic Orchestras
