City of Madeira Litigation Update September 26, 2016

On December 18, 2015, Mr. Douglas Oppenheimer filed a Complaint against the City in the Hamilton County Court of Common Pleas, Case No. A 1506891. Mr. Oppenheimer's lawsuit made a number of allegations regarding the City's ability to sell a portion of the Muchmore House Property.

A couple of months ago, the City filed a Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings, asking that the Court grant judgment in the City's favor. Both the City and Mr. Oppenheimer, through legal counsel, filed additional documents with the Court and attended hearings arguing their positions.

Last week, Judge Patrick Dinkelacker ruled in the City's favor. On September 21, 2016, he signed an Order granting the City's Motion, and dismissed Mr. Oppenheimer's Complaint.

While Council is pleased that Judge Dinkelacker ruled in our favor, it is unknown whether the Court's decision will be appealed, which would then require the City to expend additional Madeira taxpayer resources in its defense of this case.
