

Camp Dates: July 31st through August 4th

Cost: \$280.00 per child, (ages 7 to 14 years) for the two week, (Monday through Friday), camp.

Structured time with the Directors: 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. daily. For an extra \$5.00 a day you can drop your child off as early as 8:00 a.m. and pick up as late as 5:00 p.m. If you need both early drop off and late pick up it's \$10.00 for the day.

Your child's enrollment fee includes: two snacks a day, all crafts, craft supplies, field trips, a free cast photo and the costume your child will wear in the show.

Crafts: During the two weeks the kids will do costume designs, set designs, make-up designs and all other crafts we do are geared specifically to the show your child is in. Everything the kids create - pertaining to the show - is put on a large poster that they will take home on the last day of camp.

Pods: Over the past two years we have split the kids into two separate pods, and each pod did their own show. This originally started out because of social distancing, but we found the kids LOVED the two pods because gave more kids MORE lines and bigger roles. **EVERY CHILD GETS A LINE in EVERY SHOW.** Each pod will have 25 kids. A week prior to the start of camp you will get an email from us asking, 'does your child have a friend(s) that they would like in their pod?' We make sure that siblings and friends are together – all you have to do is let us know. That being said...the only time the camp kids are split into their pods is when they are REHEARSING THEIR SHOW. The rest of the day everyone eats lunch and snack together, does crafts together, plays theater games together, watches movies together...you get the idea.

Below are the show days and times for each pod.

Pod #1 will perform their show for their family on: Friday, August 4th Show times for Pod #1: 10:00 a.m. 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.

Pod #2 will perform their show for their family on: Friday, August 4th Show times for Pod #1: 11:30 p.m. 2:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The family of each child in camp will be allotted 7 tickets to see their child's show. The cost is 3.50 per ticket. If you have 2 children in the same camp you get 14 tickets, etc. You don't have to use all 7 of your tickets for the same show, you can space them out over the three performances. But be aware...once a show is sold out – it's sold out. So when we announce that tickets are going on sale you need to act immediately to get the show you want. If you really don't have preferences which show you see, you can take a bit more time before you purchase.

Now then, if you have never had a child in one of our camps you are in for a treat. We don't treat their shows like a little 'skit'...Oh no! The kids perform on full sets with lighting sound costumes, props, etc. It's like a REAL show.
