Ordinance O-2015-10

**AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO EXTENDING THE
PROBATIONARY PERIOD FOR DENNIS CORNETT FOR THE POSITION OF
PROBATIONARY FULL-TIME PUBLIC WORKS TECHNICIAN FOR AMELIA, OHIO AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, Council passed Ordinance O-2014-29, appointing Dennis Cornett to the position of probationary full-time public works technician effective July 28, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance O-2014-29 required Mr. Cornett to be CDL Class B certified within six months of employment and to maintain this CDL Class B certification during employment; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Cornett has failed to obtain his CDL Class B certification; and

WHEREAS, Council determines that it is in the best interest of the Village to extend Mr. Cornett's probationary period for an additional 90 days to allow him addition time to obtain his CDL Class B certification.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio that:

SECTION I. The probationary period of Dennis Cornett to the position of full-time public works technician on a probationary basis for Amelia Village, Ohio is hereby extended until April 27, 2014, to allow Mr. Cornett additional time to obtain his CDL Class B certification.

SECTION II. This position requires the employee to be CDL Class B certified and to maintain this CDL Class B certification during employment. Failure to meet and maintain this condition of employment may mean possible termination.

SECTION III. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.

SECTION IV. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary to approve this at the earliest possible time, in order to enable the Village to fulfill its statutory obligations to maintain its public streets and grounds. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MR. CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates;

MR. DICKERSON seconded the motion.




