2023 Trustees Report

The duties of the board of Trustees include supervising the incoming and outgoing monies of the church and overseeing the maintenance of Hope church properties.

The 2023 financial year was able to end in the positive in regard to income vs. expenses, even though we did not reach our budgeted income goal for the year. Our Expenses for the year were \$164,050.39, with income of \$184,225.52, leaving a positive of \$20,175.13. Total income brought in was up \$4,373.75 from the previous year (2022), with total expenses being lowered by \$12,866.30 in that same period. This may be a little misleading, as the main driver in the reduced expenses was the fact that we did not have a Pastor in 2023. Thankfully, in November, Pastor Peter Lurvey accepted the Interim pastor position at Hope. It is very exciting to have Pastor Peter as part of our Hope family, and we are looking forward to seeing our Sunday attendance increase throughout the year.

Our retaining wall project is about 85% complete. The old wall was removed this summer, and a new concrete wall and front steps were poured. After a closer look at the sidewalk in front of the wall, the decision was made to remove and replace that as well. The plan for spring is to cover the new cement wall with a decorative stone facing and cover the existing Hope Church sign in front with the same stone to match the wall. Special thanks to all the very generous donations made to the retaining wall project, and to Travis Quam, Aaron Lenes and Matt Wickham for all their work on the project. Thank you as well to the Beautification committee for their help and input on the wall project, as well as all the other work they do to keep the church property looking as nice as it does.

In 2022-2023 the Trustees decided to have a raffle instead of our normal Hope auction. Many people in the church and community stepped up making very

generous donations to the raffle. The drawing was held on June 11th, and proceeds from the ticket sales totaled \$5,370.00! This money was used to help fund the retaining wall project. Thank you to all the people who donated items for the auction, and all those who spent time selling tickets to make the raffle a huge success!

The Trustees have been working on other maintenance projects in the church and at the parsonage. The two ceiling fans and the center light in the sanctuary were replaced recently. This is not an easy project due to the height of the ceiling in the church, so a special thanks to James Manecke and the Fosston schools for lending us their portable lift to use for the repairs. Jeremy Minert replaced the fans and light, with Nathan Pederson transporting the lift and helping remove and replace pews—thanks to them for their time and effort.

It was noticed this spring that the soffits, fascia and gutters were in need of replacement at the parsonage. The fascia and soffits were replaced this summer, with the gutters scheduled to be installed first thing this spring. An additional sump pump was installed in the parsonage basement last spring as well to help with water issues. Special thanks to the women of hope for the thorough cleaning of the parsonage before Pastor Peter's arrival, and also for making a donation to supplement cost on some overdue painting that is needed. The hope is to get the painting taken care of as soon as possible.

With our church and parsonage aging, it is an ongoing battle to keep up on maintenance and repairs. We undoubtably will have more maintenance costs in the upcoming year, and with the upgrades in 2023, we pray that our congregation will continue their generous giving to keep our church and grounds looking their best.

The Trustees would also like to offer sincere thanks to all the staff at Hope. Tammie for all the work she does in the office, Chuck for keeping our finances in order the way he does, and of course Steve, who works more than anyone ever sees keeping the snow removed, lawns mowed and everything running

smooth around the church—and to the countless others who donate their time and talents whenever asked--Thanks to you all!

Finally, we would like to thank the Hope Church council and all of the committees for their hard work throughout the year. We are very lucky to have the dedicated volunteers we have here at Hope. Also, thank you to all the board of Trustee members for everything they do, and for all the extra hours put in behind the scenes that often goes unnoticed.
