From The Front Office:

1. At our September meeting, our auditors presented the audit report to the council along with the community. I am pleased to report the town is in excellent shape. Our auditors reported that in all the years they have done our audits, this is "the best audit report they have ever seen, and we should keep doing what we are doing".
A special thanks to our council, Suzanne Stelly, Debbie Kidder, John Ray Taylor, Jamie Huval, Kris Brasseaux and our Chief of Police Josh Ross, as well as all of our town employees that are working together to make this possible. The auditors also reported that even though they are seeing other areas sales tax revenues going slightly down or staying flat, the town has seen a four percent increase in sales tax. We have some great businesses, and we should keep supporting and promoting them as they are an integral part of our community.
2. We are actively pursuing grants to improve our infrastructure, repair and upgrade our sidewalk system, upgrade our gas meter systems, and other grants to continue to improve our beloved town.

4. We have completed the repair of all nonfunctioning fire hydrants.
