Where: We are now housed within First United Methodist Church

This is the corner of 10th St S and 1st Ave.
This is one block north of the Cass County Courthouse.
This is across the street from Boulger Funeral Home.

Entering the Building

Option 1: The west doors. This is the main entrance. Use the elevator straight ahead OR use the stairwell to the right, which goes takes you to all building levels

Option 2 (Sundays only): The north door. This door is on 1st Ave. Use the stairwell to come directly into the Chapel, or to go downstairs to the Recovery Center and Fellowship Hall. This is a great option for those wanting to preserve their anonymity.

Worship Time: 10:15 AM

We will worship in the Chapel. This is on the 2nd floor. Exit the elevator or west stairwell and turn left. The Chapel is straight ahead, just a short distance.

If you arrive by the north door, the stairwell will bring you right into the Chapel.

When in the Chapel, please make sure your beverage cups have lids! We do not enter until the prior service has ended.

Bookstore

The Bookstore is right next door to the Chapel. When facing the Chapel doors, the Bookstore is to your right.

The Recovery Center

On the lower level Recovery Worship will have a section of the building we are calling The Recovery Center. In The Recovery Center there is:

Meeting space for groups
Pastor's Office
Storage

The Recovery Center has a coffee maker.

Smoking

An area has been designated for smoking. This area is on the east side of the church building (the 9th St side). Please use the garden area next to the building.

Parking

Several options are available for parking on Sunday morning, including the 1st UMC lot on the west side of the building, the south side of the Mexican Village lot, the AMVets lot, and the lots of Boulger Funeral Home and the Court House Annex. A map is available showing these and other locations.

During the week, the lot on the west side of the church is large enough for all groups.
