Computer Projected Lines

For the past four seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game. Games where there was a difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 302-252-12 (55%) clip the last three years. That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. This year's record is 68-47 (59%). Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the HFA.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+/-" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

Lean Wisconsin (-7). † Wisconsin 30 Wake Forest 21. Full write-up in Monday's issue/update.

Music City Bowl in Nashville, TN

Missouri vs Iowa was cancelled due to COVID issues at Missouri.

Cotton Bowl in Arlington, TX

1★ Oklahoma (+3). † Oklahoma 35 Florida 28. Full write-up in Monday's issue/update. We've received a lot of complaints about this pick. When we released Oklahoma on Monday at Noon ET, the line was Oklahoma +3. It wasn't a soft line. We weren't trying to deceive anyone like some of the emails suggested. The Sooners were 3-point underdogs in the market for 8 consecutive days! We didn't just make up the line out of thin air. On Monday afternoon about two hours after we released the pick, a bunch of Florida players opted out of the game and the line moved 6 points. Please understand we cannot control what the line does after we release our picks! At the current number of Oklahoma -7.5, we would pass on the game as the line has moved another 4 points in the last 24 hours!

Thursday, December 31st

Armed Forces Bowl in Fort Worth, TX

Lean Mississippi St (+1.5). † Tulsa 24 Mississippi St 23. It was mostly a season to forget for Mississippi State at 3-7. However, the Bulldogs never gave up on first-year coach Mike Leach and have been playing their best ball down the stretch with three ATS covers in their last four games. QB Will Rogers took a majority of the snaps in the second half of the season and is completing 70% of

his passes. The defense has been solid all year allowing a respectable 28 ppg. They're taking on a Tulsa team that is 7-1 ATS on the season and really didn't have a bad performance all year outside of the ECU game. They have great balance offensively as they have three rushers that have topped 300 yards and four receivers that have topped 300 yards on the season. Zach Smith leads the way at QB but is completing just 56% of his passes. However, the best player on the team, All-American LB Zaven Collins opted out of this game. Obviously, Mississippi St played the much tougher schedule and the AAC has not impressed us at all so far this bowl season at 1-3. Our power ratings say Tulsa by only 1.3 here. We lean Miss St but the thing preventing us from liking Miss St more is head coach Mike Leach's lousy 4-11 ATS record in bowls.

Liberty Bowl in Memphis, TN

Lean West Virginia (-6.5). † West Virginia 26 Army 17. Army replaces Tennessee in this game and we were happy to see that happen as it was going to be a travesty to see a 9-2 Army team sit at home while many teams with losing records were playing. The Black Knights come into this game having just beat their two rivals in Navy and Air Force to collect the CIC Trophy. They fought through QB injuries as four different players started at that position for them. Obviously the ground game leads the way averaging 281 rush ypg while the defense allowed just 14 ppg and 271 ypg on the season. Meanwhile, West Virginia was 5-4 this season and were an improved team under second-year coach Neal Brown as they went from -77 ypg in 2019 to +125 ypg this year. QB Jarrett Doege completed 64% of his passes with a 13-3 ratio but RB Leddie Brown was the star with 945 rush yards and 9 TD's. West Virginia played the much tougher schedule as Army played 3 FCS teams and the two best teams they played in our power ratings (Cincinnati and Tulane) both beat them by at least 14 points. Our power ratings call for West Virginia by 10.1 here and in any other year, the Mountaineers would be a best bet. However, they've only played one time since November 14th and it was by far their worst performance of the season, a 42-6 loss to Iowa St. That's why West Virginia is only a lean. Also notable is WVU LB Tony Fields (Big 12's leading tackler) opting out.

Arizona Bowl in Tucson, AZ

1★ San Jose St (-9). † San Jose St 37 Ball St 24. Two teams that surprisingly won their conference championships this season. San Jose St, who hadn't had a winning season since 2012 and were just 12-37 straight up from 2015-19 come in 7-0 for the first time since 1939. The Spartans won every game by 10 points or more this year and are 6-0-1 ATS covering those by an average of 11 ppg. They are led by QB Nick Starkel who is completing 65% of his passes with a 16-4 ratio. Bailey Gaither (725 yards) leads a solid group of receivers but the biggest improvement has come on the defensive side of the ball. The San Jose St D allowed 14 ppg and 106 ypg less than what they did a year ago. Meanwhile, Ball State lost their season opener to Miami, OH in heart-breaking fashion but the Cardinals have won 6 straight games since to capture their first MAC Title since 1996. They are led by QB Drew Plitt who is completing 66% of his passes with a 16-6 ratio. The big difference though is the Ball St defense has struggled allowing 442 ypg. San Jose St was relocated to Las Vegas in the middle of the season and has shown great resiliency. The Mountain West is a much better conference than the MAC and we feel the Spartans close the deal on an unbeaten season.

Texas Bowl in Houston, TX

Arkansas vs TCU was cancelled due to COVID issues at TCU.

Friday, January 1st

Peach Bowl in Atlanta, GA

1★ Georgia (-7). † **Georgia 31 Cincinnati 21.** Cincinnati comes in unbeaten as they are the Group of 5 representative in the New Year's Six but obviously they thought they had a legit chance at the playoffs. The Bearcats outscored their competition by 23 ppg but did have close wins over UCF and Tulsa in their last two games. Those were the only two teams Cincy played that were in the top 50 of our power ratings. The Bearcats are led by QB Desmond Ridder who completed 66% of his passes with a 17-6 ratio and also added 609 rush yards and 12 TD's. Meanwhile, Georgia had high expectations this season but again fell short in their two biggest games, a loss at Alabama and a loss vs Florida. Their stagnant offense did get a boost down the stretch with JT Daniels at QB (9-1 ratio) and their defense remains stout especially vs the run allowing just 69 rush ypg on the season. Just announced on Tuesday, Georgia had three starters opt out in RG Ben Cleveland, LB Monty Rice and CB Eric Stokes. However, that is fewer than what was expected and Georgia still has a Top 5 roster in the country in terms of talent. Our power ratings even factoring in those opt out still have UGA by 7.7 here and obviously the Bulldogs played the much tougher schedule. They are also used to playing in this stadium.

Citrus Bowl in Orlando, FL

Lean UNDER 43.5. † **Northwestern 21 Auburn 20.** Auburn had a "so-so" season at 6-4 and surprisingly pulled the plug on head coach Gus Malzahn after paying him \$21 million to go away. They hired Boise St head coach Bryan Harsin but DC Kevin Steele will be the interim here. The Tigers are led by QB Bo Nix who continues to be erratic completing less than 60% of his passes with a pedestrian 11-7 ratio. He does have a talented RB in frosh Tank Bigsby (834 yards) behind him. The defense was a big disappointment this year allowing 401 ypg and 24 ppg, the most in 5 years. On the other side, defense certainly wasn't the issue for Northwestern who allowed just 16 ppg this season as they won the Big Ten West division but came up short in the second half vs Ohio State in the Championship game. Despite their 6-2 record they only outgained their opponents by 10 ypg. QB Peyton Ramsey only had a 9-8 ratio and surprisingly Northwestern has had a few players opt out after the season. Auburn could also be without three starters in Safety Jamien Sherwood, WR Anthony Schwartz and DB Christian Tuitt. Our power ratings have Auburn by 0.2 here. Usually that would equate to a best bet on these pages but the Tigers have so much uncertainty on their coaching staff especially on the offensive side with Malzahn and Morris gone. We'd rather lean UNDER and move to other action.

CFB Playoff: Rose Bowl in Arlington, TX

Lean Alabama (-19.5). † **Alabama 42 Notre Dame 20.** Alabama is back in the CFB Playoff after missing it last year for the first time. The Crimson Tide have been as dominant as ever this season outscoring their opponents by 31 ppg and outgaining them by 193 ypg despite playing only SEC competition. They will have three players finish in the Top 5 of the Heisman Trophy led by QB Mac Jones who is completing 77% of his passes with a 32-4 ratio. RB Najee Harris ran for 1,262 yards and 24 TD's and WR DeVonta Smith had 1,511 yards and 17 TD's. The Tide have scored at least 41 points in every game since the season opener. Meanwhile, Notre Dame limps in after Clemson got revenge vs them in the ACC Championship 34-10. It was yet another blowout on the big stage for the Irish who are 0-6 SU (-24 ppg) and 0-6 ATS (-16 ppg) in major bowl games in the BCS/Playoff era. They have a good team led by QB Ian Book who has a 15-2 ratio this season while RB Kyren Williams ran for 1,061 yards. However, good teams just don't cut it vs the elite of CFB anymore. ND head coach Brian Kelly likes to talk about "closing the gap". The reality is when these two met in the 2012 BCS Championship game, Alabama was a 10-point favorite. Now eight years later, the spread has basically doubled. Speaking of the spread, this is the largest point-spread in the history of the playoffs and the 3rd largest point-spread in bowl history. Tough laying it with this sort of historical number, but we could only look towards Alabama here.

CFB Playoff: Sugar Bowl in New Orleans, LA

Lean UNDER 66.5. † **Clemson 36 Ohio State 28.** These two have met four times in the post-season with Clemson going a perfect 4-0 SU and 4-0 ATS. Three of those have come under head coach Dabo Swinney who is now on 15-3 SU (+15 ppg) and 15-3 ATS (+12 ppg) runs in the post-season after his Tigers took home the ACC Championship for the 6th straight season in a dominant win over Notre Dame. QB Trevor Lawrence is completing 69% of his passes with a 22-4 ratio and Clemson has weapons everywhere including RB Travis Etienne (1,406 rush/rec yards) and WR's Amari Rodgers and Cornell Powell who combined for 1,709 yards. Clemson outscored their opponents by 34 ppg with Lawrence in the starting line-up. Meanwhile, Ohio St comes in at 6-0 as they outscored their opponents by 22 pg (+171 ypg). QB Justin Fields has completed 73% of his passes but has struggled vs Indiana and Northwestern recently throwing 5 INT's in those games and he had a thumb injury vs Northwestern that was bothering him. RB Trey Sermon did run for an OSU-record 331 yards in the Big Ten Championship game and the Buckeyes have topped 300 yards rushing as a team in each of their last three games. Dabo has made headlines by ranking OSU No. 11 and he has had no problem voicing his displeasure that OSU got in the playoffs playing only 6 games this season. We expect the Buckeyes to have a chip on their shoulders and note they are 8-1 SU (+15 ppg) and 8-1 ATS (+19 ppg) as an underdog since 2012. The only loss in that stretch was last year's playoff match-up vs Clemson, a game Ohio State felt they should have won if not for some controversial calls. The Buckeyes were missing several players down the stretch due to COVID and there is a chance some of those players could return here. Like a lot of games in 2020, more questions than answers right now. What we do lean with here is the UNDER.

Saturday, January 2nd

Gator Bowl in Jacksonville, FL

Lean NC State (+2.5). † **Kentucky 27 NC State 26.** Despite a 4-6 record, Kentucky gets an invite here. The Wildcats were outgained by 75 ypg on the season and outscored by 4 ppg. RB Chris Rodriguez did run for 701 yards and 9 TD's but QB Terry Wilson only had a 7-4 ratio and the Wildcats don't have a ton of play-makers on the offense side. Head coach Mark Stoops did say QB Wilson will get the start here but younger signal-callers Beau Allen and Joey Gatewood could also see action and also note Stoops fired his offensive coordinator after the season. Meanwhile, NC State certainly exceeded expectations this year as after going just 3-9 a year ago, they managed an 8-3 record in 2020 despite getting outgained by 27 ypg. The Wolf Pack were 4-1 in games decided by 7 points or less. QB Bailey Hockman only had a 12-8 ratio but they do have some depth on offense as RB's Zonovan Knight and Ricky Person both topped 600 rush yards and NC State had 4 receivers top 400 receiving yards. While Kentucky played the tougher schedule, our power ratings only have UK by 1.4 here and everything we've read so far indicates NC State is excited to be playing in a bowl.

Outback Bowl in Tampa, FL

Lean Indiana (-8). † **Indiana 37 Ole Miss 28.** Despite playing a shortened schedule, Indiana had one of their best seasons ever. The Hoosiers are a perfect 7-0 ATS on the season covering by an average of 11 ppg. QB Michael Penix led the way for most of the season but was injured in the Maryland game and Jack Tuttle led the upset over Wisconsin. RB Stevie Scott has 462 rush yards and 8 TD's and WR Ty Fryfogle is one of the most underrated WR's in the entire country with 687 yards (20.2 ypc and 7 TD's). It should be noted though they did get outgained by 4 ypg and Indiana hasn't played since December 5th dealing with some COVID issues the final couple weeks of the regular season. On the other side, Ole Miss had a successful first season under Lane Kiffin. The Rebels have one of the best offenses in the country as they averaged 41 ppg and 563 ypg. QB Matt Corral leads the way completing 71% of his passes but did throw 14 INT's. Kiffin told the media on Monday that the Rebels are "really struggling" with numbers. He said the team, particularly the offense, is dealing with a rash of issues ranging from injuries to COVID-19 cases to players deciding to opt out of the game. Ole Miss RB Jerriion Ealy (745 yards) and WR Braylon Sanders both sustained injuries in the regular season finale against LSU and neither appear to be ready to return. Leading receiver Elijah Moore (1,193 yards) and TE Kenny Yeboah (524 yards) opted out before the LSU game. Moore, Sanders and Yeboah accounted for 67% of the Rebels' receiving yards this season. We originally thought we were going to take Ole Miss here but there are just too many question marks for them and the Hoosiers have been the more consistent team.

Fiesta Bowl in Glendale, AZ

1★ Iowa State (-4). † **Iowa State 31 Oregon 25.** Iowa State had one of their best seasons ever. After starting the season with a dud (upset loss to Louisiana), the Cyclones have won 8 of their last 10 games with the only losses being close ones to Oklahoma St and Oklahoma. The Big 12 Championship loss to OU was especially tough considering Iowa St had the yardage edge but were -3 in TO's. The Cyclones are led by QB Brock Purdy who is completing 66% of his passes with an 18-9 ratio. RB Breece Hall had an All-American season after running for 1,436 yards and 19 TD's and the Cyclones have a solid receiving corps. Meanwhile, Oregon was basically the Pac-12 Champion by default as they got into the Championship game after Washington had COVID issues and then upset USC despite being outgained by 115 yards. The Ducks entered 2020 as one of the least experienced teams in the country and were certainly inconsistent at times especially their young QB Tyler Shough. We thought we would be leaning with Oregon here but after watching the Big 12 on Tuesday Night win and cover both bowl games and Pac-12 rep Colorado looking inept vs a short-handed Texas team, we think Iowa State is the clear play. They're the more consistent team that played in the much better conference.

Orange Bowl in Miami, FL

2★ Texas A&M (-7.5). † **Texas A&M 36 North Carolina 25.** Expectations were high for North Carolina entering the season and outside of a couple of close losses vs Florida St and Virginia on the road, they met them as they outscored their opponents by 15 ppg while outgaining them by 161 ypg. Their high-powered offense that averages 43 ppg and 557 ypg is led by QB Sam Howell who completed 69% of his passes with a 27-6 ratio. Expectations were also high for Texas A&M this year and they also delivered with an 8-1 record with the only blemish coming at Alabama. It will be interesting to see if they are looking to make a statement here after getting left out of the CFB Playoff. QB Kellen Mond leads the way with a 19-3 ratio and RB Isaiah Spiller ran for 993 yards. The defense allows just 317 ypg as the Aggies were +121 ypg playing a much tougher schedule than NC. We originally were going to take North Carolina in this match-up and then four of their best players decided to opt out of the game. The list includes RB's Michael Carter (1,245 yards and 9 TD's) and Javonte Williams (1,140 yards and 19 TD's), leading WR Dyami Brown (1,099 yards) and leading tackler LB Chazz Surratt (91 tackles, 6 sacks). Outside of QB Sam Howell, that's literally their next four most important players. Considering this is one of the biggest bowl games in North Carolina history, we were a bit surprised. Factoring in those opt outs, our power ratings now call for Texas A&M by 9.0. Also notable is that A&M runs a very similar style of defense as Notre Dame (ND DC Lea coached with A&M DC Elko for many years). That Irish defense shut down a fully-healthy NC team and we look for A&M to do the same.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Sunday, January 3rd

PHILADELPHIA 22 Washington 21. If Washington wins this game they win the NFC East and host a playoff game next week. However, if Dallas loses earlier in the day, then this game means nothing for them and they will have already clinched. The Football Team made headlines this week when they cut QB Dwayne Haskins. That ended up being an expensive trip to the strip club as he may never play in the league again. Alex Smith is expected to start here and that's a really big deal. They're 10-5 when he starts and 6-26 when he doesn't since they signed him. Meanwhile, the Eagles are just playing out what has been a disappointing season and last week was one of their worst efforts in a 20-point loss to the Cowboys. Washington won the earlier meeting 27-17 way back in Week 1 as their DL was a mismatch vs Philly's OL. However, it's tough laying points with a below average team on the road with a ton of pressure. Also notable was the look-ahead line having Philly -4.

INDIANAPOLIS 32 Jacksonville 17. Despite a 10-5 record, the Colts need help as they are on the outside looking in when it comes to the AFC playoffs. Blowing a 17-point lead last week vs Pittsburgh could weigh heavily on their minds well into the off-season. Meanwhile, it's mission accomplished for the Jags who will get the first pick of the Draft and likely get their franchise QB in Trevor Lawrence. The Jags have lost 14 straight games since the season opener and looks like they mailed in the season a few weeks back as they've lost 3 straight in blowout fashion. Shockingly, that lone win for the Jags was vs the Colts in the season opener despite Indy outgaining them by more than 200 yards. Colts get revenge but we're not running to the window to lay -14.

Green Bay 28 CHICAGO 24. The Packers haven't clinched the No. 1 seed just yet. A win here does it for them but if they lose and both the Seahawks and Saints win, they will drop to the No. 3 seed. QB Aaron Rodgers probably wrapped up the MVP after another outstanding performance last week (44-5 ratio on the season!). Meanwhile a win for Chicago gets them in the playoffs (or an Arizona loss). The Bears have been playing their best ball of the season with three straight wins and covers and their offense has scored at least 30 points in 4 straight games (first time since 1965). We lean with the Bears here but we can't take them as a best bet with the Packers series domination.

Dallas 23 N.Y. GIANTS 22. If Dallas wins and Washington loses on Sunday, the Cowboys will win the NFC East. That's shocking considering where Dallas was just a month ago. However, the Cowboys have won and covered three straight to get to this point. The Giants are also in the mix as they need a win here and a Washington loss to clinch the division. Unlike the Cowboys, the Giants aren't playing their best ball as they are on a 0-3 SU/ATS run. Still, the look-ahead line for this game was NYG -3.5 and even with last week's disparate results we don't think a 6.5-point move is justified. Dallas has won 7 straight in the series but we don't think they cover here. Totals' players note the UNDER has cashed in 6 straight NYG games.

CLEVELAND 24 Pittsburgh 17. The Steelers clinched the division last week in dramatic fashion with a 17-point come-from-behind win vs the Colts. However, QB Roethlisberger won't play here as Mason Rudolph will get the start and the expectation is that Pittsburgh will rest other starters as well. Obviously, that brings back memories to last year when Rudolph started the game at Cleveland and there was incident with DE Myles Garrett. Thanks to their WR room being decimated due to COVID, the Browns were upset by the Jets last week and need a win here to clinch their first playoff berth since 2003. The last time Cleveland laid more than a FG vs the Steelers was way back in 1989! We have a rule of thumb that we don't like laying a ton of points with teams under playoff pressure especially a franchise like the Browns that isn't used to it.

Tennessee 33 HOUSTON 24. The Titans can clinch the AFC South with a win here. Both teams come in off embarrassing losses as the Titans were crushed by the Packers on SNF and the Texans lost outright as TD favorites to the lowly Bengals. As of press-time QB Deshaun Watson is expected to start here but we question whether that will hold up. The Texans have an interim coach and would be wise to protect their franchise QB with nothing to play for Watson's surrounding cast is banged up. We think the Titans would be a great teaser option down to -1.5 and we'd still lay the -7.5 with them here.

1★ Carolina (plus the points) New Orleans 25 CAROLINA 22. New Orleans can still get the No. 1 seed in the NFC but need a win, a Packers loss and a Seahawks win. The Saints have a few extra days rest having dispatched the Vikings on Christmas. That win clinched the NFC South for them. Obviously, RB Kamara and his 6 rushing TD's made his fantasy owners very happy. Meanwhile, we cashed on these pages with Carolina last week as the controlled Washington from the outset. Carolina is on a 8-1 ATS run as an underdog. The Panthers were 7-point road underdogs at New Orleans in late-October and only lost by 3. Now they're almost 7-point underdogs at home? We like the Panthers to finish the season with another competitive effort.

NEW ENGLAND 21 N.Y. Jets 17. Obviously, it has been a season to forget for both franchises. The Patriots have clinched their first losing season since 2000 after they were embarrassed at home on MNF vs the Bills. It was the worst home loss under Belichick and it's crystal clear that QB Newton is no longer a starting QB in this league. Meanwhile, the Jets much to the dismay of their fans wanting Trevor Lawrence have pulled back-to-back outright upsets over the Rams and Browns. Not sure who wants it more but with New England -10 in the look-ahead line, we would much rather back the Pats here.

Minnesota 31 DETROIT 23. Neither team has any playoff hopes as it's been a very disappointing season for both. The Vikings have now failed to cover the spread in 6 straight games after their blowout loss to the Saints on Christmas Day. Speaking of blowouts, the Lions were embarrassed last Saturday as they lost by 40 at home to Tampa Bay. QB Stafford was hurt early in the game and as of press-time his status is unknown. Right now, we'll call the Vikings 8 points and see where the value lies later in the week.

1★ Atlanta (plus the points) TAMPA BAY 27 Atlanta 24. These two just played two weeks where the Falcons blew a 17-0 halftime lead. Atlanta, even with an interim coach has not given up on the season as they almost got the upset last week at KC as they missed a game-tying FG in the final seconds. That's four straight losses by 5 points or less. Meanwhile, Tampa Bay clinched a playoff berth last week after their 40-point dismantling of the Lions. Tampa would clinch the No. 5 seed with a win here which means they would play at the NFC East winner next week (not a bad consolation). Still, we like the Falcons to keep pace.

Baltimore 28 CINCINNATI 17. Baltimore needs a win to get into the playoffs. The Ravens are playing their best ball of the season as they have covered 5 straight games, won 4 straight and are off back-to-back comfortable wins. Meanwhile the Bengals are off back-to-back shocking upsets as first they upset Pittsburgh as 14.5-point underdogs and then on a short week on the road, beat Houston as 7.5-point dogs on Sunday. Not sure how much they'll have left in the tank here. However, the Ravens just need a win here. This isn't CFB where they need margin to impress voters and/or a committee.

Miami 23 BUFFALO 22. A win here for the Bills and they clinch the No. 2 seed in the AFC. Considering the Steelers are significant underdogs this week, we're not sure how long the Bills will want to play their starters here especially if Pittsburgh is getting beat early. Obviously, the Bills are the hottest team in football with 7 straight covers. However, they're off a big blowout win over New England on MNF and we're not sure you're going to see their "A" effort here. Meanwhile, Miami needs a win to get into the playoffs. They have extra rest having played on Saturday. The Dolphins have the No. 1 scoring defense in the NFL. We think they win this game outright but we're not anxious to make them best bet material on the road in Buffalo where they are on a 3-12 SU (-10.6 ppg) and 4-11 ATS (-7.6 ppg) run.

1★ L.A. Chargers 26 KANSAS CITY 20. Welcome to Week 17 where we have another game with a lot of uncertainty. As of press-time KC hasn't decided on who will start at QB. Obviously, there's a high probability it won't be Mahomes considering the Chiefs have already clinched the No. 1 seed. Even with Mahomes, depending on what line you got in the Saints game, the Chiefs haven't covered a point-spread by more than a 0.5-point since November 1st. They've won all 7 of those games but are 1-6 ATS. Meanwhile, the Chargers are much better than their 6-9 record. They are playing their best ball of the season with 3 straight wins and covers and we think they get another here provided Mahomes doesn't play. Note if Mahomes doesn't play, Chad Henne could get his first start since 2014.

† **Seattle 24 San Francisco 21.** The Seahawks clinched the NFC West last week much to our dismay on these pages. They still have an outside chance at the overall No. 1 seed but need help in the form of Green Bay and New Orleans losses which is highly unlikely. That means there is a possibility they could be resting starters in the second half of this one. Meanwhile, the 49ers come in off an upset win over the Cardinals last Saturday and they are not the type of franchise that will be thinking about their tee times on Monday after the season. Totals' players note the UNDER has cashed in 7 straight Seattle games.

DENVER 26 Las Vegas 25. Not much for either team to play for here. The Raiders have crumbled down the stretch once again as they have lost 5 of their last 6 games including back-to-back at home on the final play. Last Saturday's loss to the Dolphins knocked them out of the playoffs. Meanwhile, Denver QB Drew Lock has committed a TO in 11 straight games and the Broncos came up short vs the Chargers last week. We lean with the home team.

Arizona 22 L.A. RAMS 20. Just announced before we went to press, Kyler Murray will play here for the Cardinals. Arizona needs a win and a Chicago loss to get into the playoffs. Considering, Arizona will be favored here vs a Rams team starting John Wolford at QB and the Bears are sizable dogs to Green Bay, it is very reasonable. Also the Rams could be left out with a loss here and a Chicago win. Ridiculous considering where they were 9-4 two weeks ago and needed just one more win. Sean McVay is 7-0 SU and 6-0-1 ATS vs the Cardinals but we think he gets his first loss here.
