Darienne Majeske - for winning the adult category in the 2019 Rare Artist competition. The competition was open to artists with rare disorders/diseases.







Photo 1: Paul the survivor. Being completely unprepared, Paul struggled with the initial blood draw for a medical test at Rush University Medical Center, Chicago. By the time we were done, it took forty minutes, five people had to hold him down, and one of the tubes hit the floor. Mom and Paul were sobbing and needed an hour to recover.

Photo 2: Preparing for the second blood draw included watching a video (repeatedly) of a boy with autism successfully having a blood draw. We also used numbing cream on Paul's arm, gave him a Zoloft, put on his favorite shirt, took his weighted blanket and favorite pillow, prayed like crazy, and bribed him with a new Xbox game.

Photo 3: Basking in our success! Paul walked into the room like a pro, sat down in the chair and covered himself with his blanket, rested his arm on the pillow, held Mom's hand, watched with fascination at the blood draw, then gave high fives to everyone in the office. It took eight minutes from start to finish. Then he called Dad to find out the "secret code" to his new Xbox game.
