Special Update on Vaccinations for COVID-19

Just a brief update today as we've learned of some upcoming vaccination clinics and scheduling options and wanted to pass the information along:

Vaccine Clinics for La Plata and Archuleta Counties

San Juan Basin Public Health is hosting vaccination clinics on Friday at LPC Fairgrounds and Sunday at the Pagosa Springs Community Center. The 1B.3 group opens on Friday, March 5th and you may have clients who are eligible in this category. The definition of the category is below. Please help SJBPH reach this population by either signing up your eligible clients for appointments and/or sharing the link below with your eligible patients. I do ask that if you share the link that you remind those you share with that this link is only for eligible individuals according to the Governor's Phased Plan. These appointments will fill fast, so please outreach as soon as you are able to. Thank you for your help!

➤ **People 16-59 with 2 or more high risk conditions.**

○ The intent of this classification is to vaccinate Coloradans who have a high risk of severe outcomes from COVID-19. This includes Coloradans with two or more of the following: cancer (defined as patients who are currently receiving treatment or have received treatment within the last month for cancer), chronic kidney disease, COPD, diabetes mellitus (types 1 and 2), Down syndrome, specific heart conditions (heart failure, cardiomyopathies or coronary heart disease, and severe valvular/congenital heart disease), obesity (BMI $\geq 30\text{kg/m}^2$), pregnancy, sickle cell disease, solid organ transplant, individuals with disabilities who require direct care in their home, and people with disabilities that prevent them from wearing masks.

Vaccine Scheduling in Montezuma County

Southwest Health Systems is happy to announce we now have COVID-19 vaccine scheduling online! With Gov Polis' recent addition of Phase 1B.3, our current openings are on 3/5, 3/8, 3/9, & 3/11. Current Eligibility (starting March 5th)

- Are you a Healthcare worker?
- Are you an Educator?
- Are you over 60 years old?
- Are you a grocery worker.
- Are you an agriculture worker.
- Are you Age 16-59 with 2 or more high-risk conditions?
- (Cancer, CKD, COPD/breathing disorder, Diabetes, Down syndrome, Heart condition, Obesity, Sickle Cell, Organ transplant, disability that prevents them from wearing a mask).
