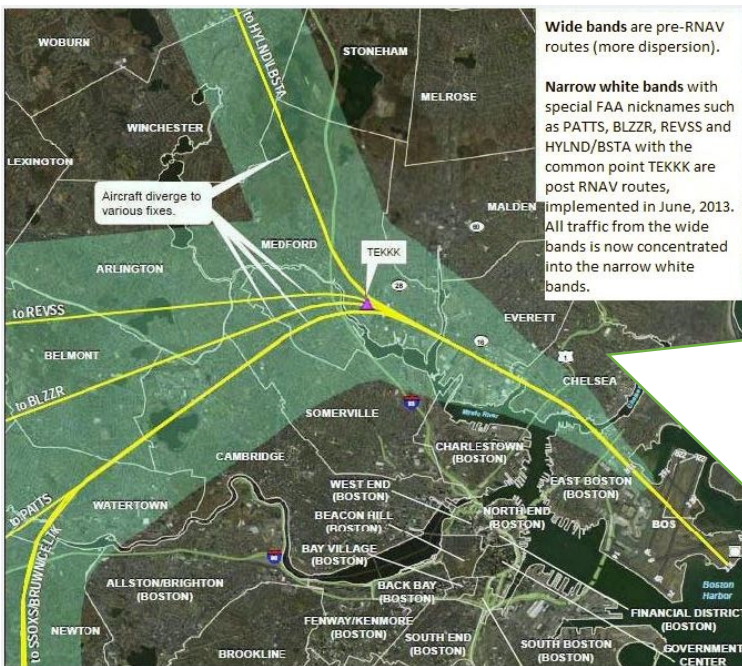




Too Much Airplane Noise?

Planes were switched in June 2013 to GPS vs. radar patterns - narrow paths nicknamed “Highways in the Sky”. Runway 33L used with NW winds sends planes on four narrow RNAV paths over specific neighborhoods. It often amounts to hundreds of planes/day, every 2 minutes or less, over the same homes. The magnitude of **dwell and persistence** is unfair. We are fighting for **Fair Skies for all**.
