## Bob's Pulled Beef (Bob Buse's Recipe From March 2015)

#### **INGREDIENTS**

5-pound choice beef roast
1½ cups Beef Broth
1 Pkg Lipton Dried Onion Soup
1 bottle BBQ sauce

#### DIRECTIONS

Put beef broth in a 6-to-7-quart crock pot and place roast into the broth. Put package of Lipton dried onion soup on top of roast. Cover crock pot and cook on high for 2 hours, turn crock pot to low and cook an additional 5 to 6 hours.

Season with BBQ sauce to taste.

Note: Depending on how many you are serving, you can vary the size and amount of ingredients. Also- use of crock pot liner makes clean up a snap.


