





SAINT MARY ANN OF JESUS OF PAREDES Feast Day March 6

Here is a story of a little known saint who lead a short life that didn't include dragons or huge miracles. She was raised in Ecuador when under Spanish control in 1534. She joined the Secular Franciscans after leading a life of prayer at home

performing charitable works. Many spiritual works were also attributed to her. She went on to establish a clinic and a school for Africans and indigenous Americans in Quito. When a plague broke out, she nursed the sick and died of the plague. She taught us by her life however that if our selfdenial does not lead to charity, the penance being practiced is for the wrong reason. Her penances made her more sensitive to the needs of others and more courageous in trying to serve those needs and in the process grew close to God and his people during her short life.
