

‘Round the Neighborhood Activities

What a variety of activities are available!

- Pickleball – The court is on the south side of the clubhouse. Players meet weekly for a friendly game. They are always willing to teach how to play and share equipment.
- Game Night – Meet at the clubhouse to play dominoes, cards or board games.
- Dominoes – meets monthly in the afternoon.
- Men’s Poker – the guys play for bragging’ rights on Wednesday evenings.
- Ladies of the Lake – Coffee and conversation, schedule varies.
- Lunch Bunch – join neighbors at a designated restaurant weekly to meet and eat!
- Water Aerobics – Head to the pool for exercise!
- Bunko – Four tables of excitement!
- Monthly Potlucks - Dinner bell at 6:00; always a variety of delicious dishes.
- Yard of the Month - To recognize neighbors who demonstrate above-average efforts in maintaining their property, contributing to the overall appearance of the community at large.

At the Clubhouse

Homeowners are eligible for key to the community clubhouse, available to enjoy 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, as long as it is not reserved. Free Wi-Fi service; Direct-911 telephone located by the pool in case of emergency.

The clubhouse is available by reservation for most private functions. There is seating for about 25, and there are additional folding tables and chairs available. The full kitchen is yours to use during an event.

At the clubhouse library, books are free to take, no checkout required. Donations are welcomed. There’s a good variety of authors, current releases, fiction/non-fiction and LARGE PRINT. The library is maintained by a volunteer neighbor who serves as the community “librarian”.

Perhaps with visitors, there may be extra vehicles, boat, camper or RV. Temporary parking is available for up to 7 nights in the clubhouse parking lot. A Parking Permit form is available on the website.
