WEDNESDAYS With the return of our 5:30 pm Mass on arvice of prayer, listening, and sacrament Wednesday evenings Vespers will now become a weekly part of this Mass. It is

a part of the Liturgy of the Hours, also known as the Divine Office. In the Liturgy of the Hours, the Church fulfills Jesus' command to "pray always" (Luke 18:1; see also 1 Thessalonians 5:17). Through this prayer, the people of God sanctify the day by continual praising of God and prayers of intercession for the needs of the world. Vespers gives thanks for the day just past and makes an evening sacrifice of praise to God (see Psalm 141:1). It is a quiet and contemplative way to end your day.

- 2. Trimming brush around the fence perimeter,


3. Clean headstones.
