

STREAMBANK STABILIZATION

Streambank Stabilization is used to stabilize and protect banks of streams or constructed channels, and shorelines of lakes, reservoirs, or estuaries. It is used to prevent the loss of land or damage to land uses, or other facilities adjacent to the banks, including the protection of known historical, archeological, and traditional cultural properties. Streambank Stabilization maintains the flow or storage capacity of the water body or to reduce the offsite or downstream effects of sediment resulting from bank erosion. It also improves or enhances the stream corridor for fish and wildlife habitat, aesthetics, recreation.
