LOOKING UP ...

With warm weather coming, we can look forward to getting outside to enjoy the Night Sky. In early evenings in April, in the western sky, most of the Winter Constellations are still visible until 9:00 p.m. or so.

Through most of April and May, Venus is visible, bright and low, in the west, northwest, at sun set. An hour before sunrise, Mars and Saturn are morning planets visible in the east. During the first half of April, they appear quite close together, mars is lower to the left of Saturn.

On April 1st, Jupiter will rise in the east, southeast, three hours after sunset. It will rise earlier and earlier as the months progress. There is a small meteor shower in April which peaks the morning of April 22^{nd} . An hour before sunrise, look south and high in the sky. The Constellations Lyra, for whom the Lyrids meteors are named, rises in the northeast about 9:00 p.m. The best chance to see these meteors is any time between April 21^{st} and 23^{rd} .
