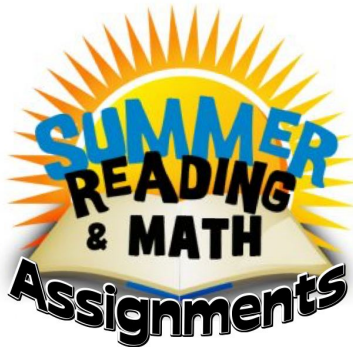

Book Report Format

Choose one of these formats for your Summer Reading book project. The report should be handwritten in black or blue ink on white lined paper or typed using Times New Roman 12. Write the title, author, publisher, and number of pages after the heading. Each report should include information on the author (see **Grading** below).

1. **Diary** – Write a 3-page (1 ½ pages typed) diary as a main character during the book's events. Include some of the dialogue and details from the book, and cite the page numbers of these details in parentheses.
2. **Sequel** – Briefly summarize (1/2 page) the plot and write a sequel (2 ½ pages). The sequel may be in play, diary, poem, or prose form (1 ½ pages if typed).
3. **Test** – List 15 vocabulary words with their definitions and etymologies (use etymonline.com for your source) and quotations from the book (cite page numbers). Find examples of 10 different Literary Terms; quote each example and cite its page number.

Grading:

Page citations/#2 summary – 20 points

Spelling and grammar – 15 points

Information – 50 points

Author information (dates, brief biography, other books/works) – 15 points
