- **From 11:45 AM until 9:00 PM, a water taxi is available to take those interested on a pub crawl. The cost per person is \$5.00 for the entire day.**

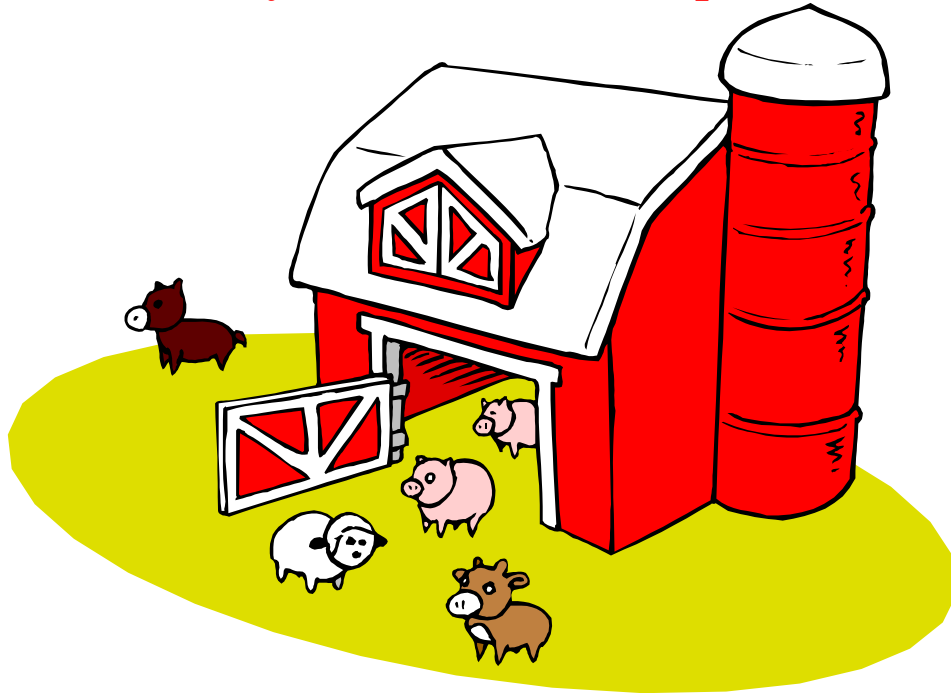

Barnyard Races & Barbeque!!!

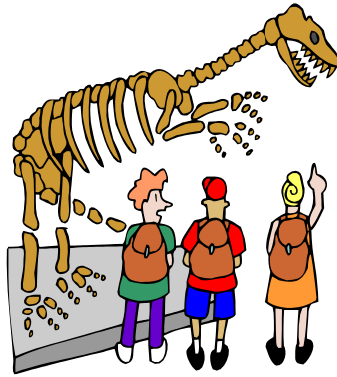


Tuesday, March 25th

Wednesday, March 26th

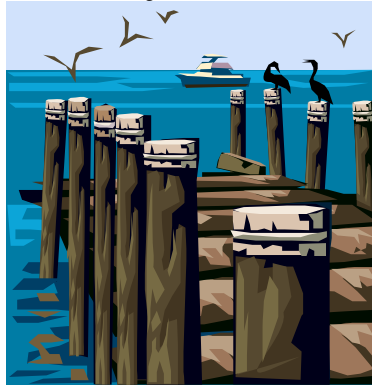
