

## SEASON 8

1. **Believing on His promise of a perfected future leaves little time to dwell on our less than perfect past.** “The LORD will perfect that which concerns me; Your mercy, O LORD, endures forever; Do not forsake the works of Your hands.” [Psalm 138:8]
2. **When times are taxing, we might want to go fishing, just like Jesus did.** “Jesus said to him, 'Then the sons are free. Nevertheless, lest we offend them, go to the sea, cast in a hook, and take the fish that comes up first. And when you have opened its mouth, you will find a piece of money.'” [Matthew 17:27]
3. **We believe God is bigger than every problem, so there is no NEED to worry. If we ever believe He isn't, there is no USE in worrying.** “Which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature?” [Matthew 6:27]
4. **Weakness need not be anything more than the place in which to Glorify God for His Grace.** “And He said to me, ‘My grace is sufficient for you; for My strength is made perfect in weakness.’ Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.” [2Cor. 12:9]
5. **Do not deny the existence of sickness and disease. Deny them any right to inhabit and affect our spirit, soul, or body.** “He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses.” [Mt. 8:13]
6. **Humble faith is believing and acting upon what God says about us, regardless of our circumstances or the opinions of others.** “No longer shall your name be called Abram, but your name shall be Abraham; for I have made you a father of many nations.” [Genesis 17:5]
7. **Every good thing is created through God's will, and in time, will come to pass.** “He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper.” [Psalm 1:3]
8. **All progress requires change, but not all change is progress.** “Now as Jannes and Jambres resisted Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, disapproved concerning the faith; but they will progress no further, for their folly will be manifest to all, as theirs also was.” [2 Timothy 3:8-10]
