A special welcome to our new Retirees. You ended your career with the most challenging year of your life, but it will make your days of retirement even more appreciated. This issue of our newsletter contains an invitation to the first in-person meeting of RC 7 in over a year which is a sure sign that we can start putting this Covid-filled, steamy, humid year behind us.

Another definite sign that summer is on its way out is the annual breakfast hosted by Comptroller Thomas DiNapoli. The event, set during the State Fair week, calls together the elected state and federal representatives to update us on their work. Included in the audience, with State Senator John Mannion emceeing the event, were many local labor leaders including NYSUT Local Presidents and Officers from the Central NY Region; the Syracuse Labor Council President, Mark Spadafora; and Unite Here Local #150 President and President of the CNY AFL-CIO Area Labor Council, Ann Marie Taliercio.

The picture makes a great reminder for us from this pleasant and informative event. Controller DiNapoli's remarks struck an important note with the retirees in the audience. He stressed how safe and well-funded two of New York States largest pension funds were. The Employee Retirement System Fund, where he is the sole trustee, and the NYS Teachers Retirement System Fund, where he appoints a member of their 10member Board of Trustees, are fully funded in stark contrast to many funds across the audited States.

We wish all of our in-service colleagues a safe and healthy new school year and hope we, in our role as a NYSUT Retiree, can all pledge to support them as their "daytime advocates"!

It's Time to Send in Your Participation Fee!

Active membership in Retiree Council 7 is open to every NYSUT retiree of any NYSUT represented group in Election District 7. ED 7 is comprised of all units in Cayuga and Onondaga counties. Active members are those who have paid RC 7's participation fee of \$10 per year and, if required by the local, payment of local retiree fees. Associate membership is open to the spouses of active members. One important note: If you are retired from Jordan-Elbridge, Liverpool, North Syracuse, Port Byron, or Syracuse City, your RC 7 participation fee is collected with the dues for your local retiree chapter and then forwarded to us. You should not use the form here or mail dues directly to us. This is a change from previous years. Participation fees are accepted at any time. However, to be able to nominate your child or grandchild for one of our June 2022 scholarships you must pay your participation fee by December 31, 2021.
