

Proverbs 8:10-11 Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold. For wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it

Proverbs 21:17 He that loveth pleasure shall be a poor man

Proverbs 26:11 Like a dog that returns to its vomit, a fool does the same foolish things again and again

Ecclesiastes 1:18 For in much wisdom is much grief: and he that increaseth knowledge increaseth sorrow

Ezekiel 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you

Matthew 10:32 Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven

Matthew 10:39 For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it

Matthew 13:17 For verily I say unto you, That many prophets and righteous men have desired to see those things which ye see, and have not seen them; and to hear those things which ye hear, and have not heard them

Matthew 15:8 These people draw near to me with their mouth, and honor me with their lips, but their heart is far from me (Heart)

Matthew 22:14 For many are called, but few are chosen

Matthew 23:13 But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you shut up the kingdom of heaven against men; for you neither go in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in

Mark 5:9 And Jesus asked him, "What is your name?" He replied, "My name is Legion, for we are many" (Demons)

Mark 14:42 Rise up, let us go; lo, he that betrayeth me is at hand (Judas betrayed Jesus) (they spit on Jesus)

Mark 13:11 And when they bring you to trial and deliver you over, do not be anxious beforehand what you are to say, but say whatever is given you in that hour, for it is not you who speak, but the Holy Spirit

Mark 15:34 And at the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, 'Eloi, Eloi, lema sabachthani?' which means, 'My God, My God, why have you forsaken me?'

Luke 6:46 "Why do you call me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say?"

Luke 6:48 he is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock

Luke 12:8 Also I say unto you, Whosoever shall confess me before men, him shall the Son of man also confess before the angels of God (NEVER deny Jesus like Peter did)

Luke 12:32 Do not be afraid, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom

Luke 16:15 You are those who justify yourselves before men, but God knows your hearts. For what is highly esteemed among men is an abomination in the sight of God

Luke 17:21 Jesus states, "Nor will they say, 'Look, here it is!' or 'There it is!' For behold, the kingdom of God is within you" (it comes from the Heart)

John 1:11-12 He came unto his own, and his own received him not. But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God

John 10:27-28 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: and I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, and no one shall snatch them out of my hand

John 13:21 "Verily, verily, I say unto you, that one of you shall betray me"

John 14:17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you

John 15:5 I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing

John 15:16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain

John 15:19 If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you

John 19:28 After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, saith, I thirst

John 20:29 Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed

Romans 1:22 Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools

Romans 1:25 They exchanged the truth about God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator

Romans 1:28 God gave them over to a reprobate mind, so that they do what ought not to be done

Romans 2:29 But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God

Romans 9:8 They which are the children of the flesh, these are not the children of God (it comes from the Heart)

Romans 9:27 concerning Israel, Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, a remnant shall be saved (all 12 Tribes Jews and Gentiles)

Romans 11:18 do not boast against the branches. But if you do boast, remember that you do not support the root, but the root supports you (quit thinking your so great, it's the root that makes you great)

Romans 14:11 For it is written, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God

1 Corinthians 2:9 Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him

1 Corinthians 3:16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you

1 Corinthians 4:7And if you did receive it, why do you boast as though you did not (humble yourself)

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price

1 Corinthians 15:53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality (your new immortal body)

2 Corinthians 5:7 For we walk by faith & not by sight

2 Corinthians 6:18 And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty

Galatians 3:29 If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise

Ephesians 3:13 Do not lose heart at my tribulations for you, which is your glory

Ephesians 4:31 Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice

Ephesians 5:5 For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God

Philippians 3:21 who, by the power that enables him to bring everything under his control, will transform our lowly bodies so that they will be like his glorious body

Colossians 2:3 In him are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge

Colossians 2:5 For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit

1 Thessalonians 2:12 That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory (God chose you)

1 Thessalonians 2:13.....ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God

2 Thessalonians 2:10-12 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie

That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness

2 Thessalonians 2:13-14 But we are bound to give thanks always to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth: (God chose you)

Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ

1 Timothy 1:9 Knowing this, that the law is not made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers

2 Timothy 3:2-4 In the last days men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy. Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good. Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God

2 Timothy 3:7 Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth

Hebrews 13:2 Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares

James 2:24 You see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith alone

James 2:26 "As the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also"

James 5:7 Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain (2 raptures)

1 Peter 1:4 an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you

1 Peter 1:8 Though you have not seen him, you love him; and though you do not see him now, you believe in him

1 Peter 1:15-16 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy

2 Peter 1:21 prophecy came not to man but Holy men moved by the Holy Spirit

1 John 2:15 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him

1 John 2:20 But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things

1 John 2:28 And now, dear children, continue in him, so that when he appears we may be confident ..

1 John 3:2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is

1 John 4:17 In this the love of God is perfected with us, that we may have confidence on the day of judgment, because as he is, so are we in this world

1 John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world

1 John 5:13 These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life

2 John 1:2 For the truth's sake, which dwelleth in us, and shall be with us for ever

3 John 1:4 I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth

Proverbs 16:3 Commit thy works unto the Lord, and thy thoughts shall be established

Ezekiel 9:4 And the Lord said unto him, Go through the midst of the city, through the midst of Jerusalem, and set a mark upon the foreheads of the men that sigh and that cry for all the abominations that be done in the midst thereof

Zechariah 13:6 And one shall say unto him (Jesus), What are these wounds in thine hands? Then he shall answer, Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends

Matthew 24:9-10, 13 Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake

And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another
