Fear of Falling: Assessment and Remediation by Sheila Greuel, MA. (2 CEs)

This two-hour presentation will assist you, the Care Coordinator, in gaining knowledge of the fear of falling by learning the obvious and subtle indicators a participant displays or expresses. You will gain knowledge of the various causes of falls from a physical and emotional view. You will also learn of remediation options to offer participants in an effort to reduce or eliminate the fear of falling and thus potentially reduce the fall risk participants experience in their daily lives.

Depression 201 by Sheila Greuel, MA. (1.5 CE available)

This 1.5-hour presentation provides information detailed information regarding the DSMV criteria for major and **minor depression** and dysthymia. The presentation also identifies barriers to treatment, and concludes with identifying and describing 3 different evidence base interventions suited for different environments of delivery. The programs include IMPACT, PEARLS and Healthy IDEAS. Specific information will be provided for linking the actions and symptoms older adults experience which indicated depression may be present. This is excellent preparation for the Healthy Ideas training in September for CCU staff.

Senior Move Management: Helping with the Transition of Their Choice

This one-hour presentation on **Senior Move Management** refers to helping an older adult when they can no longer live where they are currently living. The reasons may differ, but where they transition to is a decision they must make. It is their choice, but not an easy one to make or to carry out. Perhaps they need to move to a more accessible home so they can continue to age in place. Perhaps they need home modifications, perhaps they need some assistance from home based programs, from supportive or assisted living facilities, but not nursing home placement. This presentation gives some parameters to help caregivers and professionals support the older adult during the transition process from deciding where to go, what to take, what to do with what is not going, and a newer resource in the aging field called Senior Move Management.
