Stud Dog Class - For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog, except replace brood bitch for stud dog and produce for the get.

Brace Class - For two dogs or bitches both with at least one common owner.

PUPPY & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Entry fee \$10.00

The Sweepstakes is open to all Staffordshire Bull Terriers that, on the day of the show, will be at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age.

"Sweepstakes" and "age" division must be indicated in the space for Additional Classes on the official AKC entry form.

- All entrants in Puppy Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular classes at the concurrent specialty on that day.
- Handlers and handler assistants may NOT exhibit in Sweepstakes UNLESS they are the owner of the dog AND a member in good standing with the SBTCA. This rule also applies for any dog returning to the ring for Best in Sweepstakes. Please Note: Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- NO dog having completed the requirements for its Championship prior to the start of judging shall compete in the Puppy Sweepstakes. Any entry fee submitted for such dog shall be refunded upon notification to the Show Secretary in writing at least one-half hour before the beginning of judging.

Prize Monies

The Club shall retain 25% of total receipts to defray expenses.

1st Place - 30%, 2nd Place - 20%, 3rd Place - 15%, 4th Place - 10%

Cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person handling the dog, which will be considered the rightful recipient of the award. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the Sweepstakes judging is over. The show-giving club disclaims any liability for cash prizes after judging is complete. Any prize money allocated but not awarded shall be returned to the Club treasury.

FUTURITY/MATURITY

Entry Fee \$20.00

Puppies eligible to enter the 2024 National Specialty must be individually nominated for the Futurity.

REQUIREMENTS TO ENTER JUDGING

A. The puppy must be entered in one of the regular classes, either in conformation or obedience at the SBTCA National Specialty Show. All entries must be paid in full.

B. Futurity entry must be indicated as an additional class.

C. Futurity entry must include age division (e.g., Futurity 6-9, etc.)

D. Futurity/Maturity/Veterans classes are defined below.

E. Puppies are eligible only for the first Futurity Show that is held in conjunction with the SBTCA Specialty Show held on or after the date the puppy reaches six (6) months of age.

F. Professional handlers may only show puppies bred and owned by them.

CLASS DIVISIONS

A. There are four Futurity age divisions; 6-9, 9-12, 12-15, and 15-18.

Maturity classes will be 18-24 months and 24 months & older.

Veteran classes will be 7-9 years, 9-11 years, 11 years & older.

B. Each age group is then divided by sex.

C. First through Fourth placements are made in the judging of each class.

SEQUENCE OF JUDGING

A. Judging sequence for each age division will be Dogs 6-9, 9-12, 12-15 and 15-up and then Bitches 6-9, 9-12, 12-15 and 15-up. The same sequence will occur for the Maturity classes and the Veterans classes.

B. Best Dog In Futurity and Best Bitch In Futurity are selected from the winners of the 6-9, 9-12, 12-15 and 15-18 classes. After judging of dogs and bitches is complete the Best Dog and Best Bitch in Futurity will enter the ring together for presentation. The same will take place for Maturity & Veterans.

C. If entry numbers are low, the judging sequence will be done by sex rather than age.

Novice Open Masters

Novice Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who at the time entries close have not won 3 first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who at the time entries close have won 3 first place awards with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Masters Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who at the time entries close have won 10 first place awards in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition.

Notice: Juniors who win a third Novice Class with competition present may transfer their entry into the Open Class provided that the transfer is made at the Show Secretary's desk at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The SBTCA will hold NOHS events at all 3 specialties. Please check the box on your dog's entry form if you are eligible and wish to enter this special

Owner-Handled Best of Breed competition.

There is no additional fee for this competition.

Online entrants – Please check the Owner Handler Eligible box, or write 'NOHS' in the Additional Classes box.

Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

- Qualifying scores are required for all trophies and rosettes in the regular classes. Qualifying scores are not required for prizes in Non-Regular classes.
- Non-Regular classes are not eligible for the Special Obedience Trial trophies, nor will qualifying scores be awarded AKC legs or points towards Obedience Trial Championships.
- OBEDIENCE & RALLY MOVE-UPS WILL BE ACCEPTED ACCORDING TO AKC REGULATIONS.
- **AKC Refund Policy - Withdrawals** after the event's closing date and time due to a change of judge must receive a full refund (no fee is paid to the AKC). Females in season must be fully refunded if withdrawn after closing and no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. The Club may retain a processing fee as specified in the premium list.

PEE WEE CLASS

FREE

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- **There is a separate entry form for the Pee Wee class below. In addition to an entry form, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. These must be sent together and received by close of entries.**
- At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

Pee Wee Class Release of Liability

In consideration of being given the opportunity to participate in the Pee Wee Class at the Staffordshire Bull Terrier Club of America ("Club"), I, for myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin and I, the minor's parent and/or legal guardian.

1) acknowledge, agree and represent that I understand:

- a. the nature of the Pee Wee Class;
- b. that a Responsible Adult will accompany the minor in participating in the Pee Wee Class;
- c. I selected the Responsible Adult or am the Responsible Adult;
- d. the minor's experience and capabilities to be qualified to participate in the Pee Wee Class;
- e. the dog's propensities, size and maturity;
- f. I have selected the dog to participate with the minor AND
- g. All parties are qualified to participate in the Pee Wee class

2) fully understand:

- a. The Pee Wee Class involves risks and dangers of serious injury;
- b. These risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Pee Wee Class, the conditions in which the Pee Wee Class takes place, or the negligence of the Releasees named below;
- c. There may be other risks either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time AND
- d. I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs, and damages I or the minor child incur as a result of our participation in the Pee Wee Class.

I hereby release, discharge and covenant not to sue the Club, the American Kennel Club, Inc., their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event ("Releasees") from all liability, claims,

demands, losses or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise; and I further agree that if, despite this release and waiver of liability, assumption of the risk,

and indemnity agreement, I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releasees, I will indemnify, save and hold harmless each of the Releasees from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost which any may incur as a result of such claim, to the fullest extent permitted by law. If any portion of this release from liability shall be deemed by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, then the remainder of this release from liability shall remain in full force and effect and the offending provision or provisions severed here from.

Additionally, I and the minor child hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the Releasees harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) from any liability, claim, demands, losses or damages which may be alleged to be caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the premises or grounds.

I have read this agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it and have signed it freely and without any inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it to be complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid, the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect.

PARENTAL/GUARDIAN/RESPONSIBLE ADULT CONSENT

And I, the minor's parent and/or legal guardian, understand the nature of the Pee Wee Class and the minor's experience and capabilities and believe the minor to be qualified to participate in such activity. I hereby, dis-charge, covenant not to sue, and agree to indemnify and save and hold harmless each of the Releasees from all liability, claims, demands. Losses, or damages on the minor's account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise and further agree that if, despite this release, I, the minor, or anyone on the minor's behalf makes a claim against any of the above Releasees, I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the Releasees from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost any may incur as the result of any such claim, to the fullest extent permitted by law. I consent to the minor being photographed and videotaped for use in promoting the Pee Wee Special Attraction by the AKC and the Club and release those entities from liability from such usage.

after which time no entries may be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, or signed and no entry fees refunded. Telephoned and telegraphed entries are not accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show rules.

THESE SHOWS are governed by The American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the back side of the Official AKC Entry form in this Premium List.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS and Photocopies of entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. NO ENTRY CAN BE ACCEPTED that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of errors after closing date.

ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS & JUDGING PROGRAMS will be **e-mailed** to all entrants who provide email addresses. All others will be mailed by the USPS.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring. There is no provision for unentered dogs at this show.

THE SBTCA may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the South Buckeye Equestrian Center, the Club or any official thereof.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it becomes impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$3.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Show Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.

THE CLUB, ITS SHOW SECRETARY and Purina Farms will not be responsible for the loss of or injury to any dog or the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or other causes. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the Show premises. And, in addition, no responsibility will be assumed for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an owner, exhibitor, handler or spectator. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children at all times.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE at any time prior to scheduled time of judging of their class. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Owners or handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. There is no rule of this Club or the AKC that requires a Judge to wait for a dog.

TROPHIES AND CLASS CASH PRIZES will be awarded in the judging ring to the person showing the dog. In the event of any discrepancy from the published prize list, the Show Chairman should be advised at once. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

RECORDING & EVENT FEES: A Recording Fee of 50¢ per dog and an Event Services Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rule, Ch 11, Sec 2)

TRANSFER OF ENTRY TO BEST OF BREED: Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries for the Show but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of the earliest conformation judging at the Show.

ALL RIGHTS TO PHOTOGRAPH, televise, advertise or otherwise promote this show are vested in the Club or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the Show Site at any time while the show is in progress do, by attending and/or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, audiotape, or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.
