Conference Speakers include Peter Herbeck, Fr. Anthony Lukka, Walter Matthews, and Joshua Mazrin. **Most Rev. Frank J Dewane** will join us for lunch.

Peter Herbeck is the vice president and director of missions for Renewal Ministries. He has been actively involved in evangelization and Catholic renewal throughout the US, Canada, Africa, and Eastern Europe for more than thirty years. Peter is a co-host for the weekly EWTN television programs The Choices We Face and Crossing the Goal. He also hosts the daily radio show Fire on the Earth. He is a frequent conference speaker, has authored *When the Spirit Comes in Power* and *When the Spirit Speaks*, and has produced CDs and booklets about discipleship and life in the Spirit. Peter and his wife Debbie have four children and live in Ann Arbor, Michigan. Programs/Topics Include: Making Disciples, New Pentecost, New Evangelization, What is the Gospel? The Battle for the Family, The Culture Wars, Fatherhood, Charisms and Spiritual Gifts, Discernment of Spirits, Overcoming Sin, Forming the Next Generation, Men's Ministry

Valli Leone is a native New Yorker, originally born in Freeport, Long Island. After she and her husband, Marty, were married in 1968, they moved to Florida, where they now reside in Key Largo. She is the mother of two sons and daughters-in-“love” and six grandchildren. Her life changed dramatically when she was baptized in the Holy Spirit and delivered in many ways from pride, ignorance and fear. Valli is a commissioned Lay Minister for the Archdiocese of Miami. For many years she worked in the business and legal field, followed by nine years at Our Lady of the Holy Rosary Church as Ministries Coordinator and Religion Teacher for the School. Through the years, Valli continues to grow in the Holy Spirit, as she stays rooted in the Word of God and in the ministries of teaching, Bible study, Eucharistic and Lector ministry, Life in the Spirit, as a speaker at Conferences and Seminars, through Catholic radio, evangelization and prayer group leadership. She was part of a team of 60 priests and lay presenters and traveled with different priests to many Catholic parishes in the U.S. as a lay presenter of four-day Isaiah Missions, a Catholic evangelization effort, focused on God’s love, forgiveness, healing and empowerment to share the Good News. Valli presently serves on the Board for Charismatic Renewal in the Archdiocese of

Miami, on the Service Team of the Jesus is Lord Chapter of Miami Magnificat, as well as on the Boards of both Days of Glory, a revelation praise and worship ministry, and the Glory of House of Miami ministry for the recovery of human sex trafficking survivors. She is a member of the Upper Keys Ministerial Association, is involved in ministry as a lector, EM and prayer group leader in her Key Largo parish of St. Justin the Martyr and is also a hospice volunteer and makes weekly visits in jail ministry. Valli cherishes her cradle Catholic faith, embraces the endless gifts of the Holy Spirit, and strives daily to claim and share the joy of the Lord. She is involved in an ecumenical HOP (House of Prayer) team and wrote a book entitled, "Supernatural Joy," available through Queenship Publishing or through her own website (www.supernaturaljoy.com). Her favorite words of encouragement are: Jesus never fails!

Fr. Anthony Lukka is currently working as the parochial Vicar of the St. William Parish in Naples. Prior to this assignment he served different parishes in the diocese of Marquette, Michigan for five years. A diocesan priest from the diocese of Kanjirapally, India, Father Lukka was ordained to the priesthood on May 30, 1995. In addition to his ministry as an assistant pastor and pastor of different parishes in his native country, he also served as a post-graduate teacher in chemistry, vice-principal and principal of St. Antony's High School and Junior College for 14 years. This school had 3700 children and known for the best academic and spiritual formation in the state. He was actively involved in the Charismatic movements for the past 15 years.

Walter Matthews is the Executive Director for the National Service Committee of the Catholic Charismatic Renewal of the United States. He has served in that position since January 1993. He began working for the National Service Committee as Associate Director in May 1984. Matthews graduated from the University of Texas in December 1971 and received an MA in Religious Education from Fordham University in 1976. He has been involved in the Catholic Charismatic Renewal since January 1972 and has served in various leadership positions in the Renewal for over forty years. Prior to working for the National Service Committee, Matthews served in full time leadership in the Renewal in New York City for two years; in a parish in Rochester, Minnesota, as Director of Religious Education for two years and in the Regional Service Committee office in Minneapolis, Minnesota, for three and a half years. He has spoken at conferences, days of renewal, leaders' days and retreats throughout the United States, Canada, Jamaica, Trinidad and Japan. In April 1990 Pope John Paul II appointed Matthews to a five-year term as a member of the Pontifical Council for the Laity, the Vatican department in charge of promoting the participation of the laity in the Catholic Church's life and mission. The department is at the direct service of the Pope. His term, which had been extended one year, ended in April 1996. From January 1994-November 1996 he served a term as an Advisor to the U.S. Bishops' Committee on the Laity. He is a native of New York City and is married to the former Claire Casey. They recently celebrated their 40th anniversary. The Matthews have three adult children, two of whom are married and five grandchildren. The Matthews live in Locust Grove, Virginia.
