1908 - 1990

Beatrice "Betty" Pecha, 81, Lake Township, near Caseville, died Thursday, March 1, 1990 at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon, after an apparent heart attack.

She was born April 11, 1908 in St. Paul, Minn., daughter of the late William and Joan (Ellenbrook) Fitzgibbon.

She married Thomas Pecha June 14, 1930 in Detroit.

Mrs. Pecha moved to Detroit with her parents as a young girl. She and her husband had been coming to their cottage in Lake Township since 1949 and retired there in 1972.
