

## DELCON N. PROTZMAN

1894 - 1979

Delcon N. Protzman, age 85 of Chandler Township, passed away Friday morning, June 29 at Huron Memorial Hospital, Bad Axe.

He was born March 25, 1894 in Elkton, the son of the late George and Mary Protzman. He married Catherine E. Hazel of Harbor Beach on July 19, 1925.

Mr. Protzman was manager of the Elkton Co-op Farm Produce Co. for 25 years, and was a salesman for W. R. Grace Co. of Lansing, for 18 years, from which he retired in 1964. He was a charter member of the Elkton Rotary Club, a World War I Veteran, a life member of the Caseville American Legion Jean Post No. 543, and a life member of the Frank W. Hubbard Lodge No. 476 F & A.M. He was an active member of the Bad Axe American Legion and its Drum and Bugle Corps. Other affiliations include the Elkton Senior Citizens and the Elkton United Methodist Church.

He is survived by his wife, Catherine; two sons, Bruce Protzman of Caseville and Dr. Robert Protzman of Frankenmuth; four grandchildren, and three great-grandchildren.

Two brothers and one sister preceded him in death.

Funeral services were held Monday, July 2 at 11 a.m. from the Elkton United Methodist Church. The Rev. Joel Hurley, pastor, officiated with burial in Riverside Cemetery, Elkton.
