A. Consider and Discuss Ordinance No. 0-2019-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CISCO, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 13 “MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” OF THE CITY’S CODE OF ORDINANCES, SPECIFICALLY SECTION 13-25 “DESIGNATION OF ONE WAY STREETS”, DESIGNATING THE FOLLOWING AS ONE-WAY STREETS; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF ENFORCEMENT. (*Second Reading*)

B. Consider and Discuss Resolution No. 2019-09-23.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CISCO, TEXAS, REGARDING A FINANCE CONTRACT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROCURING AN “EXCAVATOR”.

Mr. Archer stated that the purchase of the Excavator had been approved in the 2019-2020 budget and the contract was to purchase that budgeted item.

C. Consider and Discuss Contract with E/HT for Geographic Information System (GIS).

Mr. Archer commented that the cost of the system was also included in the budget passed by the Council for the 2019-2020 budget. He further stated that the GIS system was state mandated and all municipalities must establish GIS boundaries, but it had many other features that the city would be able to utilize.

D. Consider and Discuss Accepting Bids for Oil Changes on City Vehicles.

E. Consider and Discuss Cooperative Ambulance Service Contract.

Mr. Archer informed the Council that the Ambulance Service Contract had not changed in amount and had been budgeted at the requested amount for the 2019-2020 budget year.

F. Consider and Discuss Long Range Planning.

Mr. Archer said that the Cisco Fire Department had received a FEMA grant for \$165,000.00 with only a 5% match of approximately \$7,000.00 for new equipment. He further stated that the street improvements scheduled for the current week had been postponed until next week due to inclement weather.

Lastly, Mr. Archer enumerated several upcoming events including Trick or Treat night on October 26, 2019; Cisco Night Out on October 12, 2019; City offices closed for Columbus Day on October 14, 2019; regularly scheduled meeting for October 14 had been moved to Tuesday, October 15, 2019; and lastly, that the next week would see celebration of Butch Petree's 35th Anniversary with the city.

G. Announcements from City Council.

Councilmember R. Johnson addressed citizen complaints about dogs at large. Mr. Archer explained that the city currently does not have an Animal Control Officer, but hopefully the position will be filled in the next couple of weeks.
