DESCRIPTION: The Falcon was Wing's entry level target bow. The unique Falcon was designed with features usually found only in more expensive bows. Full working re-curve, stabilizer insert, a form-fitting handle, wide over-draw and full center-sight window. While designed as a tournament bow, the 41# draw weight makes it heavy enough for hunting. This restored Falcon has a satin finish. The limbs had considerable yellowing, and much of it was removed except where the logos are located (see pics). The bow has a very comfortable grip. This bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are in good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Then taken to the range and test shot. Comes with a new rug rest and flipper rest, and a new string.
