1904 - 1993

Alex "Red" Shaw, 89 of Bad Axe, died Tuesday, May 4 at his home after a short illness.

He was born April 13, 1904 in Paris Township near Uby, son of the late Angus and Minnie (Campbell) Shaw. On Jan. 1, 1935, he was united in marriage to Luella Emer in Linkville.

Mr. Shaw attended McIntyre-Rural School of Sheridan Township. He farmed in Sheridan Township until 1968, when he retired and moved to Bad Axe.

He was a member of First Presbyterian Church of Bad Axe, where he served as an usher, deacon and member of the church board. He was also a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Port Charlotte, Fla., where he and his wife spent winters.

He was a past member of the Sheridan Township Board of Review, Huron County Farm Bureau and the Collax Grange. His interests and hobbies included playing golf and fishing and enjoying baseball and football sporting events.

Surviving are his wife, Luella; two sons, Donald and wife Judy, James and wife Ethel, all of Bad Axe; six grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

Services were conducted at 11 a.m. Saturday, May 8 at First Presbyterian Church. The Rev. Dennis Slack, pastor, officiated, with burial in Collax Township Cemetery.
