As the COVID-19 pandemic continues to be a part of our daily lives, our main priority at the Slovenian Catholic Center continues to be the health and safety of our community.

In an effort to continue to keep our community safe from the transmission of COVID-19, we will continue to follow the directions from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) as well as the State of Illinois and will continue to keep the Center closed at this time. We are hoping to be able to do a "trial" opening outdoors sometime at the end of July. We will continue to closely monitor the evolving situation and will continue to keep our community as informed as possible via email blasts and our social media sites.

At this time, all picnics "on the hill" have also been cancelled through July 31st, 2020. Although we don't have definitive direction on what will happen with the SCC annual fundraising picnic at this time, we will proceed with our annual raffle. With the Center being closed for this extended period of time, we have limited opportunities for fundraising and are hoping that our community will continue to support us by purchasing raffle tickets.

In the coming weeks, the Slovenian Catholic Center Board of Directors will be meeting to discuss and review how we could facilitate the Annual Meeting; which was cancelled in April. More information on this will also be communicated via email blasts and our Facebook page.

Once again, I am looking forward to seeing everyone soon to continue to share wonderful times and gather to make new memories as a community in our Dom.

### Dear Parents,

First, let me thank you for your support and understanding as we, a Slovenian-American community, responded to the unexpected invasion of COVID-19 in March, by closing our school. We know you missed having somewhere to go every Saturday morning, and appreciate the individual sacrifices you have all made to keep our community safe. Like me, I'm sure you have concerns and questions related to how schools plan to reopen this fall. While Slomšek Slovenian School is here to strengthen the faith and Slovenian bonds of our students, our first priority is safety. We take very seriously the safety of our students and teachers, as well as the larger Slovenian community of the Cultural Center/Slovenian Catholic Mission.

Our desire is to have the S.C.C.'s doors open so our youngsters can return to school as normal, with enhanced cleaning procedures. We hope to continue school with enhanced safety precautions such as increased hand sanitizer availability, increased frequency of cleaning of high touch areas, etc. We hope to continue face-to-face classroom instruction with increased safety and disinfecting measures, while maintaining appropriate social distancing protocols. For the safety of our vulnerable S.C.C. community, we will need to strictly follow state and local public health guidelines. This will be new to us all, and we ask for your cooperation and patience. We are all responsible for not only ourselves, but for each other.

We can only do this with your continued support. Over the summer, we will keep school families up-to-date as our plans develop. We are only as strong as the partnership we have with the families who enroll and bring their students to šola every week.
