

Rothesay Nursery School

Home School Agreement

During the Covid-19 pandemic, we are putting a new home school agreement in place. This is to protect your children/families and staff.

- Rothesay must be the only provision/setting your child attends.
 - If we contact you because your child is unwell, you must come and collect them immediately. Please check we have an up to date contact telephone number.
 - All adults must maintain social distancing, only one adult to bring your child to, and collect from nursery. Parents must remain two metres apart from other families.
 - All adults to wear a facemask when bringing and collecting children.
 - If you have to bring other children with you when dropping off or collecting, you must keep these children with you at all times.
 - Parents will hand their child over to a member of staff at their allocated entry point and set time.
 - All staff and children must wash their hands on entering the nursery.
 - No toys or equipment may be brought into the school.
 - Poor attendance may result in you losing your child's place.
 - Children should be dressed in clean clothes daily and these must be able to be washed easily.
 - We will reduce the number of resources available in the classroom to limit the risk of cross contamination and keep everyone safe.
 - Children will not be allowed to take nursery books home. Please keep book bags at home.
 - We will continue to use the outdoor environment wherever possible.
 - The provision we can offer will be subject to change due to factors, which are outside our control.

- **If a member of staff is taken ill for any reason – meaning they cannot attend work, then that class may not open, due to staff child ratios being maintained. This is until the member of staff returns.**
 - **If a child or staff member in your class is ill with Covid-19, the whole class, morning and afternoon children and staff will have to self-isolate for 10 days.**
 - **If your child tests positive for Covid-19 they must isolate along with all other members of the household and follow the most recent Government guidance.**
 - **If you refuse to have your child tested if they show symptoms of Covid-19 or are in a group that is isolating, they will not be allowed back into school until the isolation period is completed.**
