



## Yellow/Red Card Procedures (League Play)

### Yellow Card – Player/Coach

- No report needs to be filed unless you feel it is a repeat offender throughout the season
  - This can be done via email to: [info@totalfutsal.us](mailto:info@totalfutsal.us)

### Red Card Notification Procedures

- Complete the Jot Form, [Red Card Incident](#), within 24 hours
  - Info needed for the form: Date, Team, Game#, Time, Location, Player/Coach Name, Referee (Both), Reason, Comments
- Involve a “Pink Shirt” as soon as you can if you see issues are arising before, during, after the incident(s)
- Try to remove yourself from the situation in a professional manner if things get heated and have the “Pink Shirt” handle

### Suspension Guide

- Non Violent Conduct red cards will carry an immediate 1 game suspension
  - If the player/coach has a game immediately following or later same day, they must sit out the next game. It does NOT matter if it is for a team in a separate division, i.e. Red card received in a premier game and they have an MLS game afterwards
  - If they do not have another game, they must sit out their next scheduled game
- Violent Conduct (Player)
  - There will be a minimum 2 game suspension and the league will do a review of the incident and notify the player and coach of the outcome
  - If they have more than 2 games remaining in the day, they may not play until the review has been completed by the league
  - The player may stay on the bench but the coach is responsible for the players actions or if the player has an adult that can take them home they may do so
- Violent Conduct (Coach)
  - Immediately contact Total Futsal, (412) 213-8653, or have the “Pink Shirt” call
  - There will be a minimum 2 game suspension in the next consecutive games and the league will do a review of the incident and notify the coach of the outcome
  - IF there is no other coach to be on the bench, the game is to be abandoned
  - IF another coach is available, the red carded coach is to either leave the facility or reside in the Futsal office with the “Pink Shirt” until the end of the game if needed to oversee children after game
  - IF the coach has numerous games in a day, they will not be allowed to coach until the review has been completed no matter how many games they have
