Some Achievements require a public <u>vote</u> which will require a 51% majority. Some require a private vote, which should be written down and concealed. *** NOTES: 1. "≥3" reads as "3 or more." 2. For post game achievements, make notes during the game if needed. 3. "Constant" Achievements are the same on EVERY list, the rest vary list to list. 4. A complete round is from the start of someones turn until the start of their next turn. 5. 	*2*	<b>Are you not entertained?</b> <small>Gladiator (Movie, 2000)</small>	<i>Be the most entertaining player at the table (group vote post game, cannot vote for yourself)</i>	2pts								
CONSTANT (M)	*3*	<b>It just keeps going and going and going...</b> <small>Energizer Bunny (TV Commercial, 1989-?)</small>	<i>Either take a turn of 5+ minutes or take more than 1 extra turns/phases in a row (-1pt per extra turn/phase)</i>	-1pt								
	*4*	<b>Bogus. Heinous. Most non-triumphant</b> <small>Bill &amp; Ted's Excellent Adventure (Movie, 1989)</small>	<i>Eliminate a player prior to their 5th turn (-4pts PER player you eliminate BEFORE their 5th turn)</i>	-4pts								
	*5*	<b>Ha ha! You fool! You fell victim to one of the classic blunders - the most famous of which is "Never get involved in a land war in Asia"</b> <small>The Princess Bride (Movie, 1987)</small>	<i>At each turn's cleanup step, lose 1pt for each land you destroyed this turn, BEYOND the first land you destroyed this turn (THIS DOES NOT USE THE STACK)</i>	-Xpts								
ONLY ONCE PER ROUND (1)	1	<b>A liger. It's pretty much my favorite animal. It's like a lion and a tiger mixed... bred for its skills in magic</b> <small>Napoleon Dynamite (Movie, 2004)</small>	<i>Be the first player to control a Cat or an Ajani / Windgrace planeswalker (Bonus 1pt if it has an activated ability)</i>	1pt								
	2	<b>BRIGHT!!! and shiny</b> <small>Bubble Boy (Movie, 2001)</small>	<i>Be the first player to play ≥3 FOIL cards (not counting basic lands)</i>	1pt								
	3	<b>Greed, for lack of a better word, is good. Greed is right, greed works</b> <small>Wall Street (Movie, 1987)</small>	<i>Be the first player to draw ≥2 cards in 1 turn (Bonus 1pt to ANYONE that pays life to draw extra cards during the game)</i>	1pt								
	4	<b>I saw Doug playing yesterday. And I've got to tell you, this guy spends more time in the sand than David Hasselhoff!</b> <small>Happy Gilmore (Movie, 1996)</small>	<i>Be the first player to control a Desert type land OR a land with the word "sand" in it's name (Bonus 1pt if your name is Doug)</i>	1pt								
	5	<b>It's the end of the world as we know it, and I feel fine</b> <small>It's the End of the World - R.E.M. (Music, 1987)</small>	<i>Be the first player(s) to keep a creature in play through a board sweeper</i>	1pt								
	6	<b>Oh stewardess! I speak jive</b> <small>Airplane! (Movie, 1980)</small>	<i>Be the first player to play a card printed in a foreign language (Bonus 1pt if you can convincingly read it in the foreign language)</i>	1pt								
	7	<b>Status Symbols</b> <small>Unplugged (Magic Set, 1998)</small>	<i>Be the first player to control ≥5 permanents (not counting basic lands) with ≥5 different expansion symbols</i>	1pt								
	8	<b>Wait for the ramp, Morty. They love the slow ramp</b> <small>Rick &amp; Morty (TV Series, 2013-?)</small>	<i>Be the SECOND player to play an artifact that produces mana</i>	1pt								
	9	<b>You know what they call a Quarter Pounder with Cheese in Paris? A Royale with Cheese</b> <small>Pulp Fiction (Movie, 1994)</small>	<i>Be the first player to control a tribal lord (ie: "all Merfolk ...", "tap X Clerics ...", etc)</i>	1pt								
MULTIPLE TIMES (M)	10	<b>Alright, I think the next kill will be made by... Ben Richards. That boy is one mean &amp;\$\$#@#</b> <small>The Running Man (Movie, 1987)</small>	<i>Successfully choose who will eliminate the next player (Before the game, and after each elimination, secretly pick an OPPOSING player who will eliminate the NEXT player)</i>	1pt								
	11	<b>The answer to the ultimate question of life, the universe, and everything is...</b> <small>The Hitchhiker's Guide to the Galaxy (Movie, 2005)</small>	<i>Have EXACTLY 42 life (your life total must change, and return to 42 to be awarded again) (Limit 3pts)</i>	1pt								
ONLY ONCE TO EACH PLAYER (P)	12	<b>Asgard is not a place, it's her people</b> <small>Thor: Ragnarok (Movie, 2017)</small>	<i>Control a creature that's named after a region in Magic (ie: Benalish, Phyrexian, ...) (Bonus 1pt if you control ≥3 permanents featuring the same region in their names)</i>	1pt								
	13	<b>Hey, who turned out the lights?</b> <small>Doctor Who (TV Series 1963-?)</small>	<i>Eliminate a player whose Commander is at least partially white (Bonus 1pt if they are the only/last White Commander in the game)</i>	1pt								
	14	<b>I'm not an ambi-turner</b> <small>Zoalander* (Movie, 2001)</small>	<i>Complete your game having only attacked the player immediately to your right</i>	1pt								
	15	<b>Play it again, Sam</b> <small>Casablanca (Movie, 1942)</small>	<i>Play the same spell twice in the same turn (If you cast it more than twice that turn, this becomes a NEGATIVE point instead)</i>	1pt								
M	16	<b>But, if I'm still frozen in 1967, how could I have been thawed in the '90s and traveled back to. Oh, no, I've gone cross-eyed</b> <small>Austin Powers: The Spy Who Shagged Me* (Movie, 1999)</small>	<i>Play a card that continuously checks multiple players resources to determine it's effect (ie Coat of Arms, Lhurgoyf, Multani) (Limit -3pts)</i>	-1pt								
M	17	<b>See now, this is why mad scientists are generally less desirable than your common or garden variety scientist</b> <small>Mystery Men (Movie, 1999)</small>	<i>Cast a spell that includes the word(s) "chaos" or "random" in it's name or text box. -1pt per player affected by that spell (Roll a 6-sided die, this is YOUR points limit for this achievement)</i>	-Xpts
