A Message of Tithing - A Call To Repentance By Wade and Michelle Anderson

As many of you may well know there has been only one other time that we have spoken in the newsletter about tithes and offerings. Yes, we do run a little spot in the back page sharing how tithes and offerings are to be filled out and where to send them as God places it on your hearts. But, many of you might look right over that area excluding yourselves because of your incarceration. We haven't done this for the simple reason that I personally know the value of fifty cents from where you sit. In me just saying that I almost feel, in my spirit, that I am trying to lay a sob story at God's feet. God isn't looking for any sob stories folks. What He is looking for is repentance to obedience and that is why I'm presenting this message as an article, because I know you all read the articles. He holds me accountable when He speaks to me. This is exactly what James is speaking about here, "Dear brothers and sisters, not many of you should become teachers in the church, for we who teach will be judged more strictly." (James 3:1) In Proverbs 27:17, it tells us, "As iron sharpens iron, So a man sharpens the countenance of his friend." I thank God that I'm not accountable for what you all do with these messages. But I do remain accountable to God to share what He has laid on my heart. Which leads me to this ...

God has spoken to me, in my spirit, over the past month or so to write this message but I've hemmed and hawed around dragging my feet, doing this and doing that. Holy Spirit kept laying little things on my heart prompting me to write this. A little at a time I jotted down what was being given to me but listen what Paul says in *Romans 2:12-13* MSG about my delayed obedience, "If you sin without knowing what you're doing, God takes that into account. But if you sin knowing full well what you're doing, that's a different story entirely. Merely hearing God's law is a waste of your time if you don't do what He commands. Doing, not hearing, is what makes the difference with God." Because delayed obedience is still disobedience, and after my own act of repentance and now transparency, I'm finally giving all of you the opportunity to be blessed the way God's Word wishes to bless you. James 4:17 again reminds me, "Remember, it is sin to know what you ought to do and then not do it."

God has again said to me, "Why is it that you will share and encourage everyone with everything else in My Word, but not the one message where I wish to draw them away from their old ways of thinking and back to Me so that I can bless them the way that I bless you?" YES SIR ...

Let's pray: "Heavenly Father, because I know my timing was not Your timing I know I was disobedient. I do repent for this and today I believe that Your Spirit will rest on all these words, Your Words, and stir up within Your people a new and deeper understanding of tithes and offerings. We love You Lord! We know that You, Sir, are the Provider of all things good. We know that You only wish to prosper us in every area of our lives but to completely do so You need our participation. Holy Spirit we invite You to quicken our spirits and draw us all to repentance in these areas. We know there is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, so we listen with intent to serve and please You. We Love You Lord and we appreciate Your Word because it is truth and You are faithful to Your Word. We open our hearts ready to receive as You speak to each of us individually and corporately as Your children. In Jesus name we pray and believe to receive all that You have prepared for us. AMEN!"

I know that many of you are beginning to elevate your voice as you say to me, "HOW CAN I TITHE WHEN I BARELY HAVE ANYTHING MYSELF?" And that makes sense from a human perspective. There are some people that read *Matthew 10:39*, "Whenvar (Itude that Itile will lose it), and whenvar loses that Itile for lay sake will (Itud it)," and *Matthew 20:26-27*, "But among you it will be different. Whenvar wants to be a leader among you must be your servent, and whenvar wants to be a first peter 5:6, "So humble yourselves under the mighty power of God, and at the right time He will lift you up in honor" and they think to themselves, "This is ridiculous!" From a human perspective you are right, the Bible 'appears' to be a Book of paradox. Here's the definition of paradox, a seemingly absurd or self-contradictory statement or proposition ... but wait there's more, that when investigated or explained may prove to be well founded or true. Participating with God in this one principle helps us experience the spiritual realm come into the physical realm. Let's just admit it, the way we receive Salvation and eternal life doesn't make a whole lot of sense from a human perspective either, until we believe and receive His Spirit to teach us, does it? If I asked for a show of hands of those of you that KNOW you KNOW you KNOW you are saved 'nearly' every one of you would have your hands in the air, right? You believe that so I would encourage you to NOT miss out on the blessings God promises through obedience in tithes and offerings.

The true message of offerings, is not about the amount you give but that it is given from your heart. Look here for a minute at Luke 21:1-4, "While Jesus was in the Temple, He watched the rich people dropping their gifts in the collection box. Then a poor widow came by and dropped in two small coins. I tall you the truth," Jesus said, "this peor widow has given more than all the rest of them. For they have given a tiny part of their surplus, but she, peor as she is, has given everything she has." I love how the Message Translation in 2 Corinthians 9:6-7 reads, "Remember: A stingy planter gets a stingy crop; a lavish planter gets a lavish crop. I want each of you to take

plenty of time to think it over, and make up your own mind what you will give. That will protect you against sob stories and arm-twisting. God loves it when the giver delights in the giving."

Here's another important thing about your offerings, don't just throw your offering up in the wind. Hold it to God and attach a special need or desire for it to accomplish, sow it with a purpose. Holding our offerings with our hands clutched together, Michelle and I literally hold our offerings up to God, and attach a desire to it. We tell God, "Father, You've already promised to meet all of our needs according to Your riches and glory through Christ Jesus. Because of Your promises our needs are few and we thank You for that. Our desire today, as we place this seed offering into Your hands, is that You use it to increase Your Kingdom. With the resources You've entrusted to us to produce and mail the newsletter, we believe that You are helping us to reach those in need of Your love. We thank You that You bless the hearts of every person that reads them. Help us all as we dig deeper for the intimate relationship You call us to as we begin to understand who we are in Christ Jesus. We thank You Lord for Your faithfulness. Today, we sow with an expectation of a great return, and all for Your glory. In Jesus name, AMEN!"

Your offerings are seeds. No farmer buys a bag of seed, plants it in the ground and hopes it produces what they want! NO! The principle is that they KNOW when they sow a specific seed they will receive a specific harvest. Also, keep in mind that these passages thus far are speaking about offerings. Offerings are one thing and tithes are yet another. As I begin this next thought please believe me when I say, God loves what many of you are doing there on the yards in regards to helping other believers and new arrivals with some store and hygiene as they are in need. As I said, this pleases God's heart to see us reacting to the needs of others the way the early church did in *Acts 2:44-45* AMP, "And all *those who had believed [in Jesus as Savior] were together and had all things in common [considering their possessions to belong to the group as a whole]. And they began selling their property and possessions and were sharing the proceeds with all [the other believers], as anyone had need." Now I'm not alluding to you selling your TV or sneakers and giving all your belongings away. BUT if you hear God say this to you then by all means be obedient. He will return it multiplied back to you. God always blesses our obedience. I'm simply showing you in Scripture that your acts of generosity, right where you're at are Biblical.*

Jesus says, "Sive, and you will reactive. Your gift will return to you in full—pressed down, shaken together to make room for more, running over, and poured into your lap. The amount you give will determine the amount you get back." (Luke 6:38) Brothers and sisters, I don't know about you but I not only want, but so desire that my everyday life reveal Jesus in this way. Since I've given my life to Jesus and gotten a hold of this one principle my heart has been set on this one thing, "Where ever I go I see myself pushing a heaping wheel barrow full of God's blessings. Everywhere I go people keep yelling at me saying, 'Pick up all this 'stuff falling off the edges of that wheelbarrow here on the ground!'' I tell them, "You can have it. Be blessed." In Proverbs 11:25 MSG we read, "The one who blesses others is abundantly blessed; those who help others are helped." Many of us are eager to declare, "You can't out give God." Yet we don't put this one principle to the test.

There are quite a few of you that have already gotten a hold of this principle and are faithful to what Holy Spirit has spoken to you. And some of you may not even understand this is one of the greatest principles that God has set before us to test His Word in. This verse in *Malachi 3:10*, is one of the first places most people start when they talk about tithes and offerings, "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. 'Test Me in this,' says the LORD Almighty, 'and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it.'"

But the message really begins in *Malachi 3:6* where God is explaining through Malachi how they have been disobedient. The heading for this subject in my Bible reads, A Call to Repentance. Then the Lord states to His people, just like He does to us, "*I am the LORD, and I do not change.*" Declaring that He doesn't change, means we too should be thankful that He hasn't changed for us either! HALLELUJAH! He then reminds them, "*That is why you descendants of Jacob are not already destroyed* (because He never changes). *Ever since the days of your ancestors, you have scorned My decrees and failed to obey them.*" Look how God always intends to redirect us and bring us back to Him. "*Now return to Me, and I will return to you,' says the LORD of Heaven's Armies.*" (*Malachi 3:7*)

If you are one of those, like the Israelites and think, "'How can we return when we have never gone away?' ... 'What do you mean? When did we ever cheat (rob) You?'" Well here's God's simple answer. "'Should people cheat (rob) God? Yet you have cheated (robbed) Me! You have cheated (robbed) Me of the tithes and offerings due to Me. You are under a curse, for your whole nation has been cheating (robbing) Me."' (Malachi 3:8-9) Some translations use the word 'rob' in place of 'cheat' so I added it to further enlighten us to what God is saying.

Now listen in these two verses, how quickly God desires to pour out His love and blessings on us. "'Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be enough food in My Temple. If you do,' says the LORD of Heaven's Armies, 'I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won't have enough room to take

Did you know that in 1918 the world suffered a lot of deaths due to a virus similar to this one? It killed hundreds of thousands around the world. When life is moving along smoothly it's easy to say, "God answers prayer." But when a crisis like this comes along it can bring with it doubt, especially if the Lord is not responding as quickly as 'we' might like.

Isaiah 57:15-62:6

We cannot gain our Salvation through good works because our best works are not good enough to outweigh our sins. Salvation is a gift from God, received only through faith in Christ, not good works. See *Ephesians 2:8-9. (57:12)*

The high and holy God came down to our level to save us because it is impossible for us to go up to His level and save ourselves. (57:14-21)

People who die with their life of sin un-forgiven, separates themselves eternally from God. God wants them to live with Him forever, but He cannot take them into His holy presence unless their sin is removed. Have you confessed your sin to God, allowing Him to remove it? The Lord can save you if you turn to Him. (59:1-14)

Don't be discouraged when you look around and see so few people turning to God. One day people throughout the earth will recognize Him as the One True God. (60:6-7)

Under the old covenant, God ordained priests of Israel to stand between Him and His people. They brought God's Word to the people and the people's needs and sins to God. Under the new covenant, all believers are priests of the Lord, reading God's Word and seeking to understand it. Confessing their sins directly to God and ministering to others. (61:6)

Philippians 1:27-2:18

it in! Try it! Put Me to the test! Your crops will be abundant, for I will guard them from insects and disease. Your grapes will not fall from the vine before they are ripe,' says the LORD of Heaven's Armies." (Malachi 3:10-11)

You may be saying, "I don't have crop or a vineyard." Well then plant some seed and watch a rich harvest be returned back to you. Michelle and I know for a fact that when we are obedient and bless God's House He is always faithful to bless ours. Today, there is NO WAY anyone or anything could EVER keep us from tithing! We KNOW that God is faithful as we are blessed in every area of our lives. I don't mean to sound like we have no problems in our lives from time to time. But we refuse to focus on the things life throws at us. Instead, we focus on the promises of God and always remember what He has already brought us out of knowing, in His hands, He is fathful.

Earlier I painted a mental picture of a wheelbarrow full of blessings, where people everywhere are being blessed by standing on this part of the promise. "'Then all nations will call you blessed, for your land will be such a delight,' says the LORD of Heaven's Armies." (Malachi 3:12)

We are no different than the Israelites were. She also knew that God blessed her joyful, giving spirit. Michelle and I have a testimony to share that illustrates God's blessings and that His Word is true.

In the October of 2019, a friend of ours was going on a mission trip to Uganda. When she shared with our church that we could sow into her trip, the Holy Spirit said to Michelle, "Give 10% of the amount of her trip." At that point, Michelle believed it was going to be a \$3,000 trip, so Michelle and I sowed \$300 into her mission trip. In late November, Michelle found out the trip was closer to \$4,000, so we sowed another \$100 to completely cover the 10% that the Holy Spirit spoke to Michelle.

We know deep in our hearts that God continues to place the needs of the Overcomers for Strist ministries on people's hearts everywhere. Now, let's continue with the testimony.

In December of 2019, I went to check the P.O. box for mail. As usual there were many letters there. And like always I sit in the parking lot and sift through them to see who has written. At that point, I ran across a letter without a D.O.C. number on it so I pulled it out to make sure it was in the right P.O. box before I left for home. I then realized I knew who this was from and we generally didn't get mail from them so I opened it and began to read it. This is the gist of what it said:

Hello Wade and Michelle. When we last visited with each other I had asked you several different questions about the ministry. We know that you both are doing a great work for the Lord and know even more now the cost of Bibles, printing and mailing the newsletter every month. We also know you are good stewards of the resources you receive. God has placed it on our hearts to send you this check in hopes that it will cover the cost for this coming year, 2020. God bless you for all you do. We love you.

I unfolded the check that was inside and I literally cried, thanking God for His faithfulness. It was in the evening so it was already a challenge to read in the dark car let alone through the tears of thankfulness. I looked at it several times to make sure I was really reading the correct amount. The check was for \$4,000! Let me tell you all, even as I write this I tear up. When I reached home I still could hardly compose myself as I handed it to Michelle to read. Her response was, "WOW!" She looked at the envelope to check again where it came from. Right after that I lifted the check to God and prayed, "We thank You God that You are already blessing their obedience in every aspect of their lives. Their health, their business, their family, their children and their finances. We're believing for a 100 fold return on their gift. In Jesus name, AMEN!"

The way that I see it is God multiplied our seed of \$400 by 10 times, and that multiplication blessed the Overcomers for Effriet ministry.

Listen to what Paul says here in 2 Corinthians 9:8, "And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work." It's through our obedience and in direct connection to trust and believe God for His Word that we give back, only ten percent, to God for what He has already supplied. Paul continues on, in 2 Corinthians 9:10-11 by encouraging us with, "Now He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness. You will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God." Let's read how the Message Translation states 2 Corinthians 9:10-11, "This most generous God who gives seed to the farmer that becomes bread for your meals is more than extravagant with you. He gives you something you can then give away, which grows into full-formed lives, robust in God, wealthy in every way, so that you can be generous in every way, producing with us great praise to God."

Folks, it doesn't matter which translation we use, these Scriptures are as plain as day. God is the One that supplies the seed for us to sow, and from that same seed it produces 'bread' for us to eat. We already receive a double portion! We don't give to get, however, the promise remains, "@tva, and it shall be given unito you; good measure, pressed down, and shalran together, and running ever, shall man give into your besom. For with the same measure that yo mate withel it shall be measured to you again." (Luke 6:38 KJV)

Here's a simple illustration I presented to our grandsons when they were young. "Take two exact same size jars and set them on the shelf. Write 'God' on one and your name on the other. Every time you earn even a dollar take ten cents out of it as soon as you get it and place it in the 'God' jar. Then place the other ninety cents in your jar." After awhile they would ask me, "Grandpa, why is it that 'God's' jar only has a little in it and I already need another jar?" "Exactly!", I'd say. "God is not trying to take your money. He simply wants your heart to believe in Him for ALL things." Of course, we follow the very same principle in our lives that I presented to my grandsons. Whether it be \$2 from a \$20 pair of handlebars or \$800 from the sale of an \$8,000 dollar motorcycle, God always gets His ten percent before I ever spend a dime of what I received.

As I bring this in for a landing I want you all to know and understand, any and all of your tithes and offerings sown into any ministry/storehouse is to be done in obedience to God. Some people have a hard time giving to a big mega church or some seemingly well-to-do pastor. They 'think' that pastor has gotten 'rich' off of the tithes and offerings given to that church. That's what holds those people back from receiving this one principle, their lack of true understanding of who they are giving to. You are NOT giving to the man, you are giving to God! The sconer we all get past that the quicker we will begin to receive the provision given with the promise. In order to truly receive we have to trust God and participate with Him. Tithing takes faith, and He is faithful.

The Bible tells us to look at the fruit that trees/people/organizations produce. Jesus says in *Matthew 7:17-18*, "A good tree produces good truth, and a bad tree produces bad truth. A good tree ean't produce bad truth, and a bad tree can't produce good truth, and a bad tree can't produce good truth." The Message Translation explains *Matthew 7:17-18* the 'good tree' or organization like this, "Don't be impressed with charisma; look for character. Who preachers are is the main thing, not what they say. A genuine leader will never exploit your emotions or your pocketbook."

Likewise, I am NOT trying to persuade you to sow or tithe to the Orchandre for Official. I am NOT trying to get your money. I'm simply attempting to provide you with the Biblical information so that you too can be blessed at the level God intended for you to be blessed. NONE of this is a money issue. It's a heart issue that God is confronting.

The Bible clearly indicates that we are to tithe to the 'storehouse'. In the spiritual sense it's the 'storehouse' that supplies our spiritual food.
