

ICE SKATING -Plymouth Mill Pond

Skate rentals are not available. A warming shelter sells snacks and warm drinks. For hours and latest information, call 920-627-SKATE (7528).

Directions: Exit right out of The Osthoff parking lot and turn left at the stop sign (Hickory Lane). Turn right at the next stop sign onto Hwy 67 South. Follow Hwy 67 South into Plymouth. Turn left on Elizabeth Street, right on Caroline Street, then left on Main Street to the mill pond.

Lakers Ice Center (indoor skating)

1202 S. Wildwood Avenue, Sheboygan.

Skate rentals are available for \$3. Admission \$4 for children 12 and under; \$5 for ages 13 and over. For public skating times, call 920-458-7465.

Directions: Exit right out of The Osthoff parking lot and turn left at the stop sign (Hickory Lane). Turn right at the next stop sign onto Hwy 07 South. Follow Hwy 07 South to Hwy 23 East. Continue on Hwy 23 East into Sheboygan. Exit onto Taylor Drive, and turn right, continuing on Taylor Drive South to New Jersey Ave (Kohler Credit Union and Aldi Foods will be on the left). Turn left on New Jersey Ave., and turn right on S. Wildwood Ave. to the Ice Center.

Directions: Turn left out of parking lot, follow Osthoff Ave to stop sign. Turn right onto Rhine Street. Turn left onto Hwy 67 North. High School will be on the left, and the hill is directly after high school.

CROSS COUNTRY SKIING -Kettle Moraine State Park

Enjoy the exquisite scenery around you as you experience an adventure in the Kettle Moraine State Park. Ski rentals are not available. 608-266-2181.

Directions: Turn right out of the Osthoff Parking Lot. At four-way stop sign, turn left onto Hickory Lane. At stop sign, turn right onto Hwy 67 South. Continue on Hwy 67 South to Hwy 23 West. Follow Hwy 23 West to County A. Turn left on County A South to County T (Greenbush), continue on County T until you see Kettle Moraine Drive. Continue left on Kettle Moraine Drive one mile – trail head is on the right.

Ski rentals are available. Enjoy a day of fun at Sunburst Ski Resort, where you will enjoy several different trails of downhill skiing and tubing. *Directions: Turn right out of The Osthoff parking lot. Follow Osthoff Ave. to stop sign. Turn left onto Hickory Ln. to next stop sign. Turn right onto Hwy 67, and follow Hwy 67 signs through Plymouth. Travel on Hwy 67 for approximately 26 miles to Hwy 45. Turn South (left) onto Hwy 45 through Kewaskum. Turn right at McDonald's and follow the Sunburst Ski Resort signs.*



SNOWSHOEING ·

Ledge View Nature Center (Chilton) - 920-849-7094, W2348 Short Rd, Chilton

Traditional wood-framed snowshoes are available to rent when there is a minimum of 6" of snow. \$5 rental fee. Snowshoeing options: (1) Rent snowshoes and explore trails on your own (staff must be present to provide the rental). (2) Make a reservation for a scheduled snowshoe hike filled with fun activities and discoveries. (3) Bring your own snowshoes and enjoy the trail. Weekdays, 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m., Weekends, 10 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Directions: Turn left out of Osthoff Parking Lot. At stop sign, turn right to next stop sign. Turn left onto Hwy 67 North and travel approximately 6 miles to the intersection of Hwy 67 and Hwy 57 in Kiel. Turn left onto Hwy 57. Follow Hwy 57 through Kiel and New Holstein, toward Chilton. Turn left (West) on Quarry Road. Turn left (South) on Irish Road. Turn right (West) on Short Road and watch for the Nature Center on the right.
