

NEW YORK CITY

- Marching Bands - play in the Macy's Parade on Thanksgiving
- Perform at the Intrepid Sea, Air, & Space Museum, then spend time among the amazing exhibits

BOSTON



- Tour Boston, site of many of America's important historical events
- Attend a concert by the Boston Pops Orchestra or the Boston Symphony in Symphony Hall
- Learn in a workshop with a member of the Boston Pops Orchestra or a clinic with a professor from Boston University's College of Fine Arts
- Perform in local venues including churches and historic buildings, and participate Boston's Heritage Music Festival
- Enjoy a music exchange with a local high school

PHILADELPHIA



- Visit the home of American Independence where the Declaration of Independence and Constitution were written and signed
- See the statue of Benjamin Franklin, the Liberty Bell, Philadelphia City Hall and Independence Hall, then spend time in the Philadelphia Museum of Art or hear the Philadelphia Orchestra in Verizon Hall
- Participate in the Philadelphia Heritage Music Festival

WASHINGTON DC



- Tour the American capital and see all the great institutions – the Washington Monument, Lincoln Memorial, Capitol building and the White House
- Perform in the Cherry Blossom Festival, on the Millennium Stage at the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts or at Arlington National Cemetery
- Wander through the 19 museums of the Smithsonian Institution

NORTH, SOUTH and WEST - MONTREAL, FLORIDA and CHICAGO

Extend your East Coast USA trip to one of these cities. All host a Heritage Music Festival at different times of the year and are home to many iconic American things to see and do ...

- Montreal – 'Paris of North America' is a little piece of France just across the Canadian Border

- Chicago – the 'Windy City' on Lake Michigan in the US Mid-West is famed for its architecture and museums, including the Art Institute with its expansive collections
