January 28, 2026

- ◇ Bob B. called meeting to order 7:00 pm, meeting was recorded:

- ◇ Pledge of Allegiance recited.
- ◇ Review of minutes from Dec 30, 2025. Rachel motioned to accept the minutes, Bob 2nd, passed. Minutes posted to the township website.
- ◇ Rachel: **Treasurer's report** as of Jan 28, 2026:
 - ✘ Revenue from insurance refund, revenue share, and tax disbursements, and the QHERPP (Qualified Heavy Equipment Rental Personal Property) was a total of \$23,775.54. Payments included a large bill from last year's audit of \$8,250, payroll and taxes, and normal expenses and totaled \$16,157.76. Totals were: General fund – \$46,472.01, Savings account – \$78,779.39, Fire Fund – \$6,804.82, Road Fund – \$155,213.75, and Tax collection – \$125,255.21. Grand total of \$412,525.18. Bob motioned to accept treasurer's report as presented and pay bills. Leona 2nd, roll call, passed.
- ◇ **Public Comment:**
 - ✘ Christopher BPF – 24 calls: YTD 316, 88 more calls, with a 33% increase in volume. The trend is expected to continue. Forceable entry training, team skills drills and normal truck maintenance occurring this month.
 - ≥ 4 downed powerline calls in Goodwell
 - ≥ 1 medical call in Goodwell
- ◇ Bob: **Zoning report:**
 - ✘ Took care of boundary line issue on Cottonwood. Has another boundary line issue on Baseline. Needs to discuss with Planning board about butcher/sales of select cuts of meat. Yearly 19 zoning applications, 1 voided. Also had calls regarding land divisions to take place later in the year.
- ◇ **Planning:**
 - ✘ Dave G. – Planning board tabled discussions on ADU's and Data Centers to update the Master Plan to deal with those issues.
- ◇ Leona: **Clerk's Report**
 - ✘ Took in ballot bags for inspection and certification.
 - ✘ Signed the Early Voting contract with the County.
 - ✘ Got an offer to learn the voting machines at the county clerks office. Will take advantage of that.
 - ✘ Did online training for QVF (Qualified Voter Files)
 - ✘ Printed and mailed W2s.
- ◇ **Old Business:**
 - ✘ Cemetery Ordinance put off until next month.
- ◇ **New Business:**
 - ✘ Poverty Guideline Resolution due by February 1. Bob read the resolution. Rachel motioned to accept, Bob 2nd, roll call passed.
- ◇ **Public Comment:**
 - ◇ Clint questioned the asset level of \$10,000 on the resolution was answered by another resident saying that it excluded home and one vehicle.
 - ◇ Rachel mentioned water was frozen at the hall – deferred to Tim.
 - ◇ Rachel motioned to adjourn, Leona 2nd, passed. Meeting ended at 7:16 pm.
